### Slander Alleged In \$5,000 Suit

Damages of \$5,000 are asked of George Raphael in a Circuit Court suit filed by Zelda Phillips, who alleged he slandered her in a letter to another man.

The complaint says Raphael accused her in the letter of the theft of \$1,000 of his money. The remark was introduced in evidence in Reedsport justice court before Justice Fred Wright and some 20 witnesses, she says.

The City of Reedsport and Police Officer Robert P. Murray were named defendants in two Circuit Court automobile accident suits.

Majorie Loree, plaintiff in one suit, asks \$5,000 general damages in an accident involving a Reedsport police car driven by Murray Dec. 6, 1950. In the other complaint, Grayden D. Loree asks \$2,500 damages in the same accident.
