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Zioncheck Case Judge Passes On

WASHINGTON (AP) — Municipal Court Judge Walter J. Casey, 57, who twice fined the late Rep. Marlon A. Zioncheck of the state of Washington, died at his home Monday night of a heart attack.

Zioncheck in the 1930's kept the capital in a furor with his exploits for nearly a year before ending his life in a leap from a Seattle hotel window.

Casey, then on the municipal court bench for only five months after his appointment by the late President Roosevelt, first tangled with Zioncheck on a drunkenness charge.

He fined the congressman \$10

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for drunkenness and \$5 for disorderly conduct after Zioncheck engaged in a telephone-ringing spree in an apartment house.

Later in April, 1936, Zioncheck forfeited \$25 collateral on a charge of driving 70 miles an hour on a Washington street. Casey wasn't satisfied.

He ordered Zioncheck brought in to court bodily, ignoring the congressman's statement that "Judge Casey is just looking for publicity." This time Zioncheck was fined \$25 for contempt of court.

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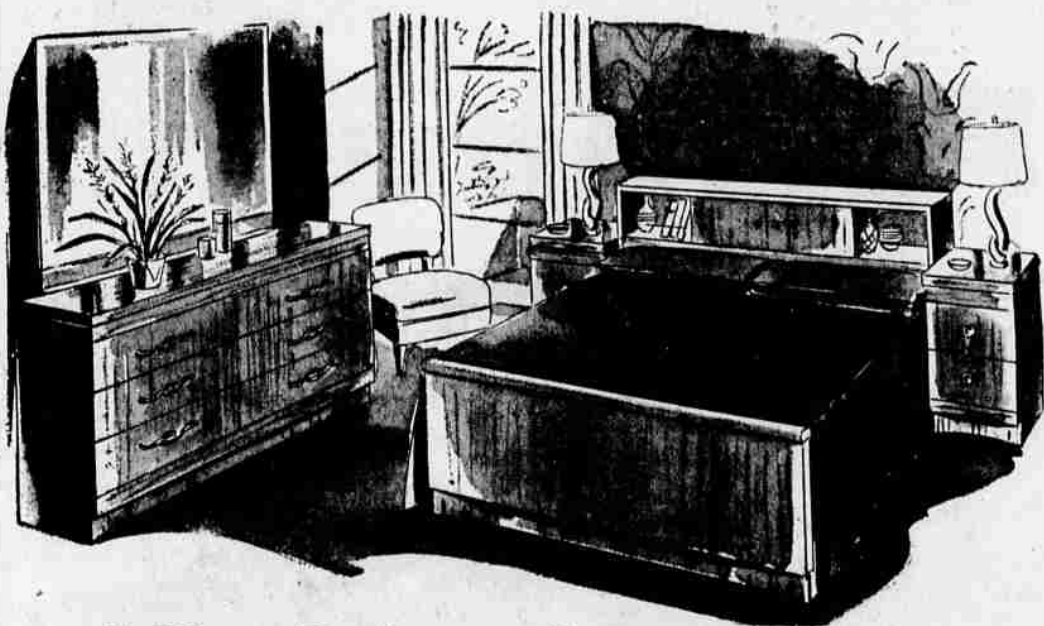
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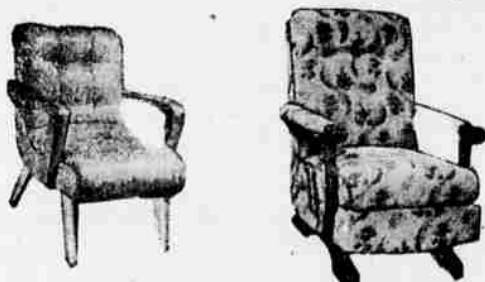
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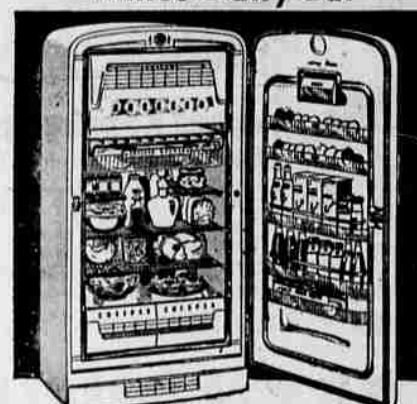
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
