SALEM (AP)—Jack Putnam, who lost \$1,178 in a poker game three years ago, got his money back Wednesday in Marion County Circuit Court.

He lost the money to J. P. Schimberg, whom Putnam sued for \$2,356, or twice the loss.

Circuit Judge George Duncan issued a directed verdict for only the actual loss.

THREE PERISH IN FIRE

CHICAGO (AP)—Three persons perished in a fire which swept a three-story brick apartment building early Friday. Firemen rescued a dozen persons from the top floor of the building on the city's south side. Another 100 persons fled to the street in sub-freezing weather.

Fire officials, who estimated damage at \$8,000, said cause of the blaze had not been determined.
