Sawlogs Steady In Willamette, Douglas Marts

OREGON STATE COLLEGE— Sawlogs held about steady in the Willamette Valley and Douglas County last week.

Demand continued generally good but there was some tendency toward lighter grading and scaling. Stumpage prices and most other forest products were unchanged.

SAWLOGS: No. 2 second-growth sawlogs at Willamette Valley mills ranged from \$38 to \$47 a thousand, mostly \$38 to \$40. No. 1's were \$31 to \$38. Second-growth, camp-run logs ranged from \$35 to \$42, mostly \$38 to \$40 in the valley and at Roseburg. Mixed second and old-growth ranged up to \$45. Eight-foot logs down to 6 inch diameter were \$16 to \$18 a cord, or \$36 to \$38 a thousand in the valley. Roseburg mills paid around \$33 a thousand for 8 and 16 foot logs down to 8 inches.

STUMPAGE: Second - growth Douglas fir stumpage prices have not changed much in the Willamette Valley since July. Excellent shows were around \$20 a thousand. Good shows brought \$15 to \$18. Average shows were around \$12, and poor shows ranged down to \$10. Stumpage in Douglas County averaged \$5 to \$7 less for each grade.

POLES AND PILING: Long poles were generally in good demand. In the Willamette Valley, 55 foot barksies ranged from 28 to 34 cents a lineal foot, depending on diameter. At Roseburg, 55 foot peeled poles were 31 cents.

PULPWOOD: Pulpwood demand was limited. Unpeeled hemlock, spruce, and true firs were \$15 to \$17 a cord. Unpeeled Douglas fir was \$15.

HARDWOODS: Alder, ash and maple brought \$32.50 to \$34 a thousand in the Portland area. Alder was in good demand at Lebanon at \$35.

OTHER FOREST PRODUCTS: Sword fern brought 14 cents a bunch. Dry cascara bark was 12 cents a pound.
