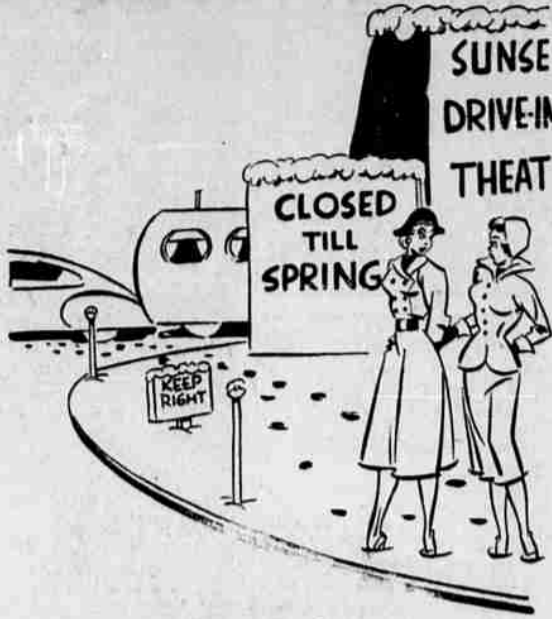

NORTH ADAMS, Mass. (AP)—The five-point deer antler on display in an Adams cafe was bagged by a rabbit hunter who didn't fire a shot. Robert S. Shafter said he was hunting near Windsor Pond Thursday when a buck appeared suddenly and charged. He knew his shotgun was not suitable for deer and also that the deer season would not open until Dec. 1. Instinctively, he related, he dropped his gun and seized one of the buck's antlers. The deer kept going, leaving the five-point antler in Shafter's hands—an antler he would not have lost normally until next spring. College Proxy Urges Fraternity Equality

NEW YORK (AP)—Dr. Henry M. Wriston, president of Brown University, says college fraternities should conduct themselves so that "no one in the world" can say he is not treated with equality. Wriston touched on the subject of discrimination in accepting the gold medal award for 1952 of the National Interfraternity Conference Friday. Sixty fraternities represented at the sessions have an enrollment of 1,365,000. Delegates and officials at the conference were occupied by the issue of discrimination on grounds of race or color although it was not on the official agenda of the conference.

Britain Finds Uranium Source in Old Mine

LONDON (AP)—Geologists may have found Britain's first native source of uranium in an abandoned, flooded mine in Southwest England. The workings, known as the South Terras mine, are near St. Austell, Cornwall. Government officials said it contained uranium ore apparently rich enough to be mined commercially. Preliminary surveys indicate there may be several million pounds of ore in the area.
