

Powers Hoopsters Trounce Camas Valley, 69-9, Tues.

Coach Rod Petty is still shaking his head from the terrific 64-9 walling his Camas Valley hoopsters took at Powers Tuesday night. Superintendent Martin Yoder, who watched the game, said, "If Powers continues as hot as it was last night, it will be reckoned with again in the state playoffs. They were wonderful to watch." Not only did the Redskins have height, but finesse far above what might be expected for a first game of the season, Yoder said. The first squad played only two quarters and fairly made the floor sizzle with its fast break. In the first quarter, it ran up a 20-1 margin, and in the third quarter rolled up 21 points to Camas Valley's single free throw.

All-state Prospect Joe Boutin led scorers with 14 points, eight of them in the third quarter. Six-foot four-inch Richard Spitzmass dumped in 11, Bob Walker added 10 and Guard Bob McMahan added another 10.

Camas Valley was definitely outclassed, but was not as bad as the score indicates. It was just one of those bad first nights when the

hoop is the size of a needle eye. Center Warren Nickelson was high scorer for the losers with five points.

The Powers crew also posted an easy victory, 38-5.

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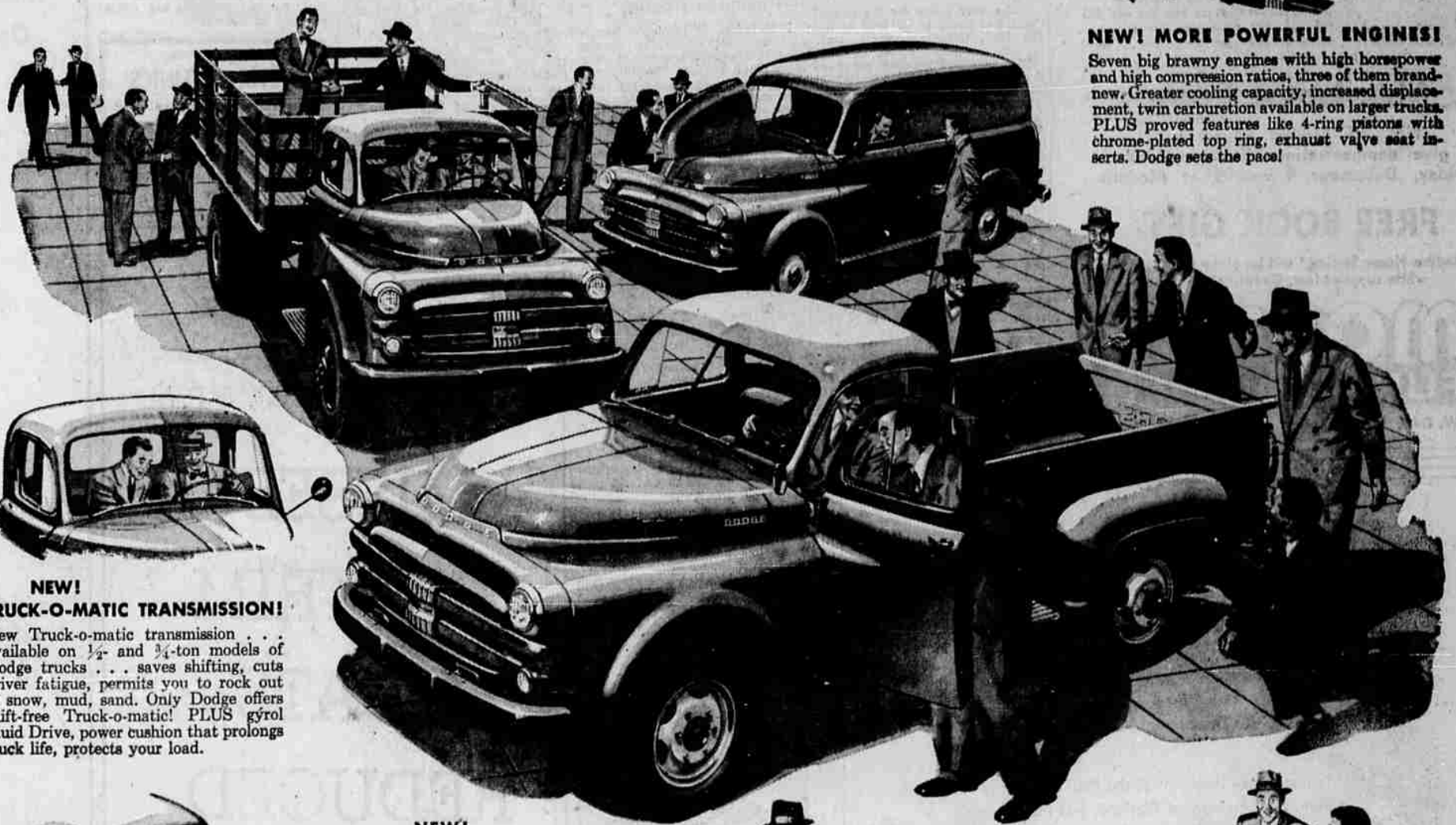
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
