Bodies Of 13 Plane Crash Victims Found

RIVERSIDE, Calif. (AP)—Air Force medical corpsmen from Norton AFB were set to scale Mt. San Geronimo Friday to bring down the bodies of 13 men killed in the crash of a C-47 transport Dec. 1. Sixteen medics, headed by Capt. Oscar L. Robinson, were assigned the tough job of recovering the remains from the 10,000-foot level of the rugged peak. A ground party returned from the crash scene late Thursday and reported the three crewmen and 10 passengers apparently died instantly. Condition of the bodies prevented immediate identification. The plane crashed in a storm on a flight from Omaha to March AFB, Riverside. Snow and the rugged 11,485-foot San Geronimo kept would-be rescuers from reaching the crash scene for a week.
