Death Hits First Victim On The Dalles Span Job

THE DALLES — A bank of earth collapsed Wednesday afternoon and claimed the first victim of construction of The Dalles bridge across the Columbia River. The earth, on the Washington side of the river, went down as Arthur J. Ziesmer, 25, of The Dalles, was standing on it. He was unconscious although buried only to his chest, and fellow employees thought he might have struck his head on a portable drilling rig in falling. After 35 minutes of resuscitation effort, a physician pronounced him dead. He was a recent arrival from Kalispell, Mont.

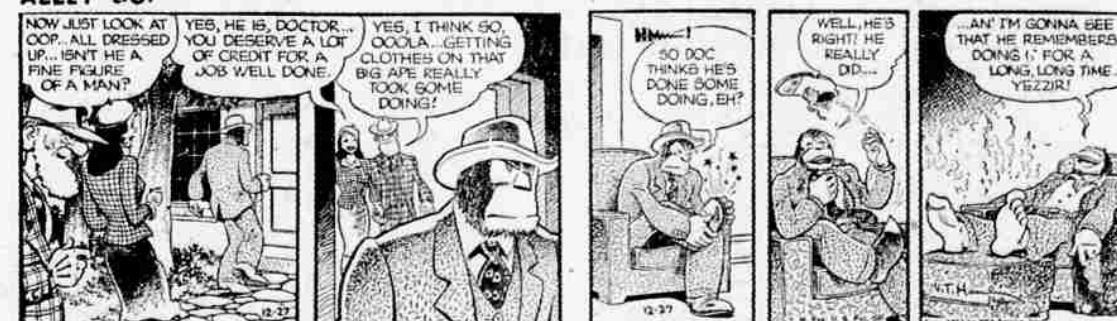
