### U. S. Ahead Of Russia In Atomic Arms Race

WASHINGTON (AP)—The United States is well ahead of Russia in the atomic arms race and must stay that way, says the senior House Republican member of the Senate-House Atomic Energy Committee.

Rep. W. Sterling Cole (R-N.Y.) slated to become either chairman or vice chairman of the group, also said in a radio interview Sunday:

1. The military, not the Congress, must decide whether to use atomic weapons in Korea.
2. Each atomic weapon so used is one less in the stockpile to deter any Russian plan for all-out war.
3. There is unavoidable waste but no evidence of corruption in the atomic program.

### Excess Profit Taxes May Not Be Continued

WASHINGTON (AP)—Several veterans on the House Ways and Means Committee today predicted that excess profits taxes, now yielding about 2½ billion dollars a year, will be allowed to expire June 30.

But Rep. Eberhart, (D-Pa.), a sponsor of the tax, forecast a fight by some Democrats to extend it.

The tax which can run the government's take up to 62 percent of business profits, was imposed shortly after the Korean War started in mid-1950 to help pay for defense expansion and diminish any war profiteering.

The present law carries an automatic June 30 expiration date. Congress can extend the controversial tax as it, rewrite it or simply let it die.
