### Hollywood Producer Convicted Of Contempt

WASHINGTON (AP)—Sidney Buchman, former well-known Hollywood writer-producer, was convicted Thursday of contempt of Congress.

The charge was based on Buchman's failure to appear before the House Un-American Activities Committee for questioning Jan. 29, 1952.

U. S. District Judge T. Blake Kennedy allowed Buchman, an admitted former Communist, to remain at liberty on bond pending sentence Monday. He faces a maximum sentence up to a year in jail and a \$1,000 fine.

### Missing Convict Found Hiding in Building

SALEM (AP)—Convict Marcellus Winters, 28, who was missing from his cell Tuesday night, was found late Wednesday hiding in an industrial building inside the walls, Prison Warden Virgil O'Malley said.

Winters, serving 10 years from Clackamas County for assault with intent to kill, was transferred to the segregation unit Thursday.

### Health Department To Get Gamma Globulin

PORTLAND (AP)—The Oregon State Health Department expected to receive this week its first shipment of gamma globulin, serum made from blood, used to combat disease, including infantile paralysis.

Some 1,000 two cubic centimeter vials have been shipped by the Pittman-Moore Drug Co., Indianapolis, Ind., to the health department. The scarce serum is distributed through health departments throughout the country.

Gamma globulin has been used for several years as a vaccine against measles and infectious hepatitis. Tests have indicated it also may give immunity against polio.

### Wardens Study State Prison

SALEM (AP)—Three prison wardens from Illinois, Idaho and South Dakota will arrive here Sunday to make a "progress survey" of the Oregon State Penitentiary, Gov. Paul L. Patterson announced Thursday.

The wardens, who were designated by the American Wardens Association at the request of the State Board of Control, are Joseph E. Ragen, warden of the Illinois State Prison at Joliet; L. E. Clapp, warden of the Idaho State Penitentiary; and G. Norton Jameson, warden of the South Dakota Prison.

Leo Utecht, warden of the Minnesota State Prison at Stillwater, was to have been one of the three. But when Utecht quit his job Wednesday in a policy disagreement with the Minnesota supervisor of institutions, the Board of Control decided he shouldn't come. Jameson was named in Utecht's place.

Gov. Patterson said he hopes the wardens' report will be ready before the Legislature adjourns.

### Mortgaged U.S. Ships Deal With Red China, Claim

WASHINGTON (AP)—Sen. McCarthy (R-Wis.) said Monday his Senate investigating committee has been informed that 45 ships on which the United States holds mortgages have engaged in trade with Red China.

He said 51 other ships on which the U. S. has mortgages "have traded behind the Iron Curtain" in Europe.

McCarthy announced that the Senate Committee, which he heads, will hold public hearings on the matter soon. He set no definite date for them.

McCarthy said in a statement that the 96 ships in question were sold by the Maritime Commission and that this country holds mortgages on them in the amount of 25 million dollars.

"Of these ships, 52 are registered in Greece, 49 in Italy, and four in France," McCarthy said. He added:

"Those ships have made a total of 183 voyages behind the Iron Curtain, 78 to Communist China, and 105 to Soviet bloc ports in Europe."

### Catholics Planning To Construct Monastery

SALEM (AP)—The Roman Catholic order of Trappists is planning a monastery on the slopes of Red Hills in Yamhill County, the Oregon Statesman reported in a news story Tuesday.

The order, one of the strictest in the Church, is negotiating for 1,400 to 1,500 acres of partially cleared farm land near Lafayette, about five miles east of McMinnville, the paper said.

It added that C. E. Terry, a retired farmer and real estate broker, had already sold the order.
