U. S. British Troops Quele Trieste Rioting

lice broke up the crowd with tear gas and clubs and arrested scores. U.S. Ambassador Clare Booth Luce conferred with Italian Premier Giuseppe Pella. She returned to the embassy in time to see the demonstrators seize a fire truck and turn hoses on police and toss tear gas bombs back.

Ten thousand demonstrated in Milan and marched on the British consulate, but were turned back by police.

The British and Americans announced Oct. 8 that they intended to turn over administration of Zone A of the Trieste territory, including the city, to the Italians. Yugoslavia declared its troops would march into Zone A the moment Italian military forces were sent in. Tension over Trieste, always a hot issue between Yugoslavia and Italy heightened.

Friday's Trieste rioting, involving an estimated 9,000 persons, was the worst of the three days in this city of predominantly Italian population.

signed his name Richard Cordon; a British prisoner, Andrew M. Cordon, and a South Korean, Kim Man Su.

First Sgt. Richard G. Cordon of East Providence, R. I., is listed among American prisoners who the Reds said refused to come home.

The main demand, Thimayya said, was that the NNRC "censor such mail" to filter out all material urging them to return.

"I asked them what we should do in the case of a letter from a man's wife who writes, 'Oh, darling, please come home to me,' and they seemed a little unclear on that point," said Thimayya.

"We may work out some arrangement to read off the names and addresses and let them pick out the letters they want," the general said.

The prisoners complained they had received a lot of "stereotyped letters" from people they did not know.

2 County Stores Are Burglarized

Two widely separated store burglaries occurred in Douglas County Thursday night, according to the sheriff's office.

One was at Oakes Grocery in Wilbur, the other at Lyle's in Days Creek.

Burglars walked off with \$14 or \$15 at Wilbur. No report of loss at Days Creek was available Friday morning, Dep. Sheriff Larry Wright of Canyonville is investigating the burglary at Lyle's.

Dep. Sheriff E. A. Schwader is continuing investigation of the Wilbur job. He said entrance was gained by prying a back door lock loose. The burglar or burglars then picked up a pair of canvas gloves from a rack, went to the front of the store, picked up the cash register and took it to the back of the store. On the floor behind the meat counter, the drawer of the register was pried open, after which the gloves were laid on top of the machine. The store owner said nothing else was believed missing.

At Days Creek, Dep. Wright said about \$9 in change was missing from Lyle's Grocery and Service Station, along with a 48-can case of condensed milk.

ed that the showing "affords little comfort to lumber shippers . . . who have suffered more shortage in cars desired than is shown for any other area served by the defendant."

Mohundro also declared that Southern Pacific "enjoys what almost amounts to a monopoly in Western Oregon" except for the territory served by Oregon Electric Railway Co. in the Willamette Valley.

He also pointed out that the railway has discouraged routings through Portland where cars could be shipped by Union Pacific or other northern lines.

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
