Voracious Appetite Of Child Aged 5 Has Italian Papa Worried

ROME — Luciana Barbonis, 5, eats five meals a day, in which she usually consumes 14 bananas, five beefsteaks, vegetables, fruit and a handful of vitamin pills. She has to eat that much, doctors say. She has an intestinal tract 21 feet longer than normal, but with very weak absorption. She gets little nourishment from her food.

Vittorio Barbonis, her father, came to Rome to try to lay his problem before Prime Minister Giuseppe Pella. "On a salary and family allowance totaling 40,000 lire a month (about \$65) how can I feed her?" he asked. "Besides, she has five other brothers and sisters."

Spear Fishers Protest Being Shot For Seals

EVERETT — A move is under way among Puget Sound spear fishermen to place distinguishing marks on their hoods so they won't be shot at as seals.

The latest of several such reports of being mistaken for seals and being fired upon has come from Jack Meyers, Seattle. Mrs. James Blanchard, secretary of the Puget Sound Mud Sharks, reported Saturday. He was spear fishing near Edmonds. Another man whose name she did not give said he had just ascended to the surface, looked ashore and saw a man taking a bead on him with a rifle. He shouted and the man did not fire. Later however the man told the fishermen he yelled just in time.

7 Killed, 22 Wounded In Hunting Season

By THE ASSOCIATED PRESS Seven persons died from accidental gunshot during 1953 hunting seasons in Oregon. The State Game Commission also received reports of 22 persons being wounded in hunting mishaps. The death victims were: Mrs. Clarence Barnes, about 42, Milton-Freewater; Gilbert Gabrielson, 23, and Richard C. Roadman, 29, both of Portland; Wayne Gordon Olson, 14, Medford; Jack Eastham, 29, Astoria; Jimmie D. Hooker, 24, Albany, Ore.; and Edwin Cecil McLaren, 48, La Grande. In addition at least 14 hunters suffered fatal heart attacks in the woods and three persons were killed in traffic accidents while traveling to hunting sites.

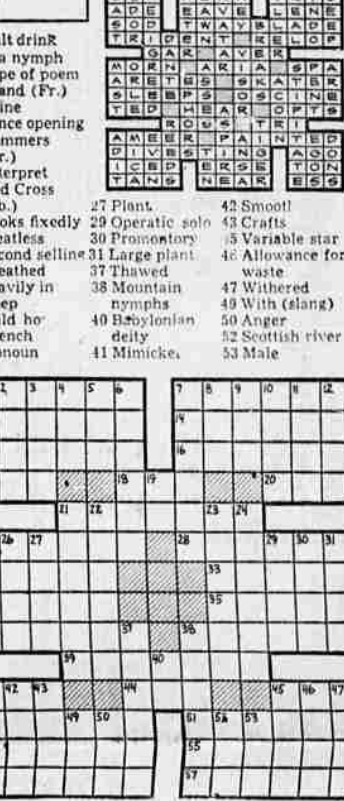
