Mexico Closes Borders In Retaliation To U.S.

MEXICO CITY (AP)—Mexico closed its borders Saturday to farm workers seeking jobs in the southwestern United States. The action was in retaliation against a U.S. "stop gap" plan for admitting the workers.

In Washington, U.S. State Department sources said that despite the sharp Mexican opposition, the United States would go ahead with its new temporary plan. It calls for the Labor Department to set up stations on the U.S. side of the border for registration of workers.

Under a U.S.-Mexican agreement which expired at midnight Friday night, the Mexican government did the recruiting in the interior and sent the laborers to the border for admission.

Two Initiative Ballot Titles Are Completed

SALEM (AP)—Ballot titles for two initiative measures have been completed by Atty. Gen. Robert V. Thornton.

One would prohibit commercial fishing in coastal streams south of the Columbia River. The other, filed last week by Elmer Deetz, Canby farmer, would repeal the state's milk control law.

Sponsors of the fishing ban measure are Allen R. Gordon, Salem; Edward Lindsay and Vance A. Taylor, both of Corvallis; F. Ross Brown, Albany; and Walter N. Brown, McMinnville.

Signatures of 37,404 registered voters are required to put an initiative measure on the November general election ballot. They must be filed by July 1.

Peace Prize Ceremony Disturbers Are Fined

OSLO, Norway (AP)—Three young Reds who interrupted the awarding of the 1953 Nobel Peace Prize to Gen. George C. Marshall last month have been fined a total of \$500 kroner (\$112).

During formal presentation ceremonies at Oslo University, 20 Communists shouted against Marshall and showered the audience with leaflets before the police could hustle them out.
