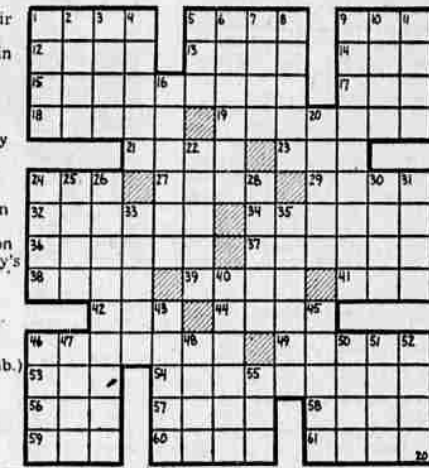

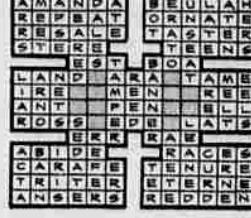

Mutual Korean Pact Approved

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Senate Foreign Relations Committee Tuesday approved the mutual defense treaty with South Korea but made clear this country will not support any aggression by that republic.

The committee voted to attach to the pact a clause stating that both parties are obliged to aid each other only in the event of "an external armed attack" against one of them.

The clause was suggested by Sen. George (D-Ga.) and accepted by the committee unanimously to make it definite that the United States is not required to aid any armed move by South Korean President Syngman Rhee to unify Korea.

Secretary of State Dulles told the committee last week he thought it was clear that the treaty carried no obligation for the

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Release Asked Of U. S. Officer

VIENNA (AP) — The U. S. Army in Austria has asked Soviet army authorities to release a 23-year-old American lieutenant missing a week and believed to be in Russian hands, it was announced Tuesday night.

The U. S. Army identified the officer as 2nd Lt. William Donald Adkins, 23, of Indianapolis, Ind., who has been missing since the morning of Jan. 12.

The U. S. Army released the text of a letter sent by U. S. commander in Austria, Lt. Gen. William H. Arnold, to the Russian

commander, Gen. S. S. Berlov, demanding the officer's release. Arnold's letter said Adkins "has been under investigation by U. S. Army agencies in connection with certain personal financial difficulties."

"This investigation indicates that Adkins may have been suffering from a mental breakdown," the letter said.
