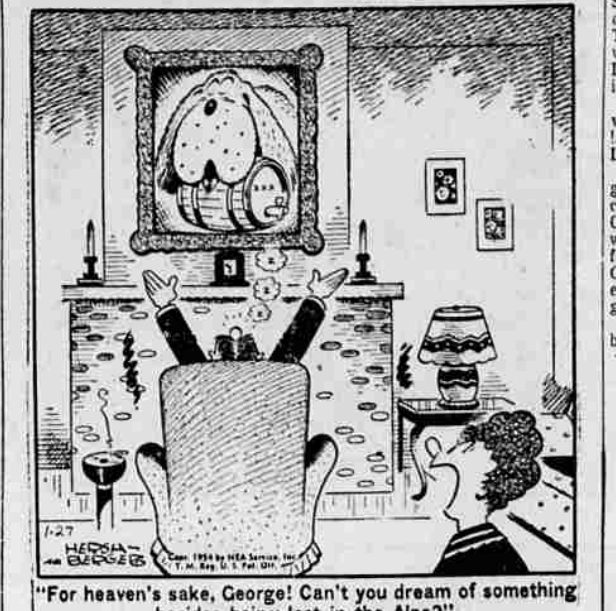

NEW YORK — Motion picture rights to Charles A. Lindbergh's autobiography, "The Spirit of St. Louis," have been sold for what may be the largest price ever paid for a literary property, his agent says.

The famed aviator's literary agent, George T. Bye, disclosed the sale Monday, saying an undisclosed cash down payment and a percentage of the film earnings may total more than a million dollars.

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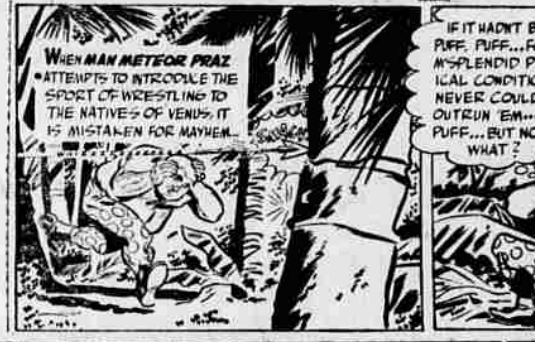
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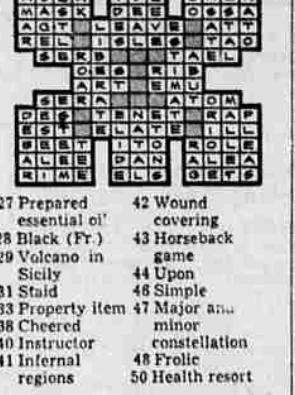
