Mrs. R. M. (Hazel Dell) Gaugler, 59, died suddenly Wednesday night at her home near Myrtle Creek.

Mrs. Gaugler was born Jan. 23, 1895, at Council Bluffs, Iowa. She moved to Myrtle Creek two years ago from Lemmon, S. D., where she lived for 38 years. She was a member of the All Souls Catholic Church, Myrtle Creek, and was active in the Altar Society.

The body will be shipped today by Gans Mortuary, Myrtle Creek, to Evanson and Son Funeral Home, Lemmon, S. D., and burial will be in the Catholic Cemetery there.

Detective Shoots Woman, Kills Self In Seattle

SEATTLE (AP)—A detective's gun ended an argument he had with a 27-year-old police bureau clerk in her home Wednesday night as the two died of bullet wounds inflicted while the woman's horrified 5-year-old son looked on.

The victims were Mrs. Lugenia Teal, a divorcee, and Detective Dale Schmeiser, 35, married but separated from his wife.

Chief of Detectives Victor L. Kramer said Schmeiser and Mrs. Teal had been arguing in Mrs. Teal's house when Schmeiser drew his service weapon and fired one shot.

Mrs. Teal, a bullet wound in her chest, ran next door to the home of Mr. and Mrs. Visco Karabach. Mrs. Karabach said she heard a thump on the porch and ran out.

Mrs. Teal screamed "Call an ambulance. He shot me."

Then, Ricky, the woman's son, ran from the Teal home, screaming and crying, followed by Schmeiser, who put a gun to his head and shot himself.

Mrs. Teal was dead on arrival at a hospital; Schmeiser apparently was killed outright.

Mrs. Teal was the daughter of Stuart Whitehouse, former Tacoma and Seattle newspaper man who now is a freelance writer. She attended Whitman College in Walla Walla after graduation from Seattle's Franklin High School.

Kramer said later he had always known Schmeiser as a quiet and competent worker and "nothing in his work was indicative of what happened tonight," Schmeiser had been assigned to the bureau detail.

The shooting occurred about 7 p. m.

Ired Taxpayer Pays Blood Money

DES MOINES, Iowa (AP)—An irate taxpayer, who paid part of a \$13,542 federal tax claim with a tubful of silver dollars over which he had poured two buckets of blood, threw the U.S. tax office into a furor here.

The taxpayer, Robert Friel, 27, of Council Bluffs, said he staged the dramatic incident to "raise hell" with tax collectors because he said they had harassed his parents during an investigation of his finances. He said he got the blood from a pack of ketchup.

He drew the ire of Iowa Internal Revenue Director Frank Halpin, who accused him of defacing U.S. money. But after the Secret Service ruled that the silver dollars were not permanently damaged, Halpin agreed to accept the payment. However, he insisted that Friel count it. That took Friel more than two hours. The payment added up to \$4,997.

India Gives 'Protection' To 88 Korean Prisoners

NEW DELHI, India (AP)—India announced Thursday that the 88 Korean prisoners of war who went to go to neutral countries will be kept under military "protection" at an army cantonment near New Delhi.

A Foreign Ministry spokesman said the men, who refused repatriation, were "simply being given protection until their future is settled."

"We do not consider them prisoners any longer," he declared.

The contingent—74 North Koreans, 12 Chinese and 2 South Koreans—sailed Tuesday from Inchon, Korea, with 1,600 of the 6,000 Indian troops who guarded the more than 20,000 unrepatriated POWs in the Korean demilitarized zone.
