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Brenda Kelley Spared Testimony At Mele's Trial

NEW YORK — Glamorous Brenda Frazier Kelly, pictured on the verge of a "psychotic state," has been spared giving testimony in the assault trial of Pietro Francesco Mele, Italian movie director and society playboy.

The 30-year-old Mele is accused of battling and battering police men who tried to escort him from Mrs. Kelly's Park Avenue apartment last Nov. 10. Mele apparently had entered the apartment despite the objections of the dark-haired society belle, 1938's debutante of the year. The couple had spent the evening nightclubbing.

The trial opened Wednesday in special sessions court with testimony by Mrs. Kelly's chauffeur and three patrolmen.

The chauffeur, Gerald Kelly, said Mele wanted to go upstairs for a good-night drink but that Mrs. Kelly said "no." He said Mele went up anyway.

Patrolmen Duncan Christie and William Murray and Sgt. William Kelly all told of Mele's battle in the apartment and out into the street.

The prosecution's star witness was expected to be Mrs. Kelly.

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Whaling Ships Put Out To Sea At Coal Harbor

COAL HARBOR, B. C. — The 20th-century version of "Tar she blows" sounded across the Pacific Ocean's stormy waters today as six sturdy boats started a hunt for 600 whales.

The ships left here Wednesday and will range from 100 to 200 miles out of this shore station deep in Quatsino Sound on the northwest coast of Vancouver Island.

They seek humpback, finback, sei, blue and sperm whales in the only whaling expedition known to operate this far north in the Pacific.

They will conclude their search six months from now. It is hoped the catch will be big enough and expenses small enough to show a profit—a result obtained only once before in the six years of operation by the B. C. Packers, Ltd. Five vessels, with 25-man crews, harpooned 338 whales last year in a season cut short two weeks by a Pacific storm.

Interceptor Pilots Get Advanced Twin Jets

PORTLAND, Me. — The interceptor pilots protecting this part of the Pacific Northwest are getting new, advanced twin-jet planes. The first F-86 Scorpion landed at the Portland Air Force base Wednesday, and more are expected in daily deliveries for the next month. The squadron based here has been flying single-engine F-44 jets.

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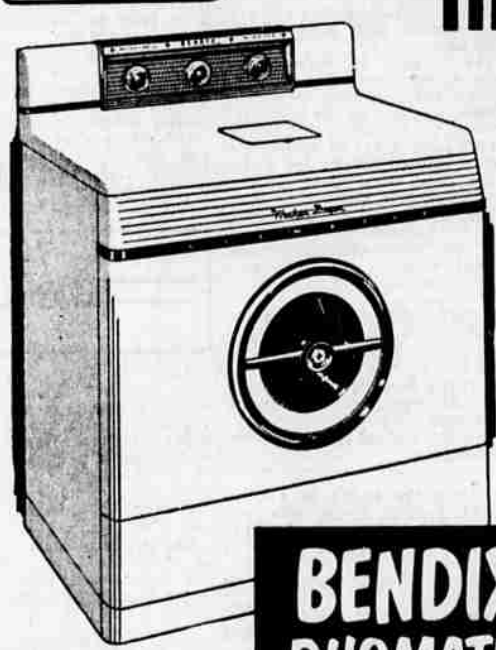
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
