Oregon's Traffic Death Rate Drops

Oregon's traffic death rate has been declining steadily since 1936, Secretary of State Newberry disclosed. Records show that on a mile-for-mile basis, travel in Oregon today is nearly three times safer than in 1936 when the death rate for 100,000 miles traveled stood at 15.7 persons killed in traffic. In 1953, the death rate was 5.8. Safety men attribute the steady decrease, achieved despite increased motor vehicle registration and subsequent increases in miles traveled, to better highways and a traffic controls plus better enforcement and improved driver attitudes.

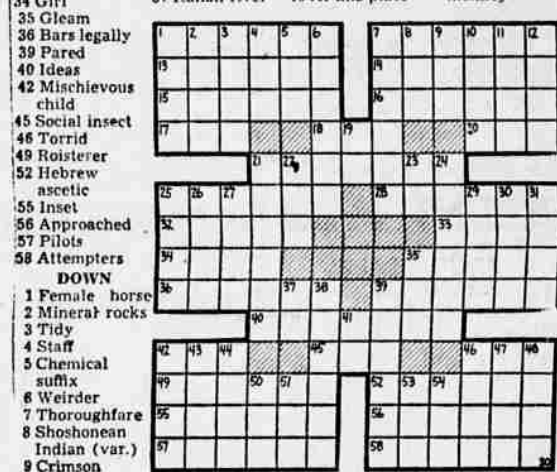
