

Euzkadi Concert Proves Different Entertainment

Local audience reaction, while generally favorable, was mixed in regards to the presentation of Euzkadi, Basque native singing, dancing performance here Tuesday night. But those attending had to admit it was something different in Community Concert presentations.

It is often difficult for Americans, schooled in Hollywood perfected entertainment, to understand the folk lore of far-away lands, especially that which is of the more unusual nature.

But the performers of Euzkadi did combine unusual singing talents with their native dancing and tableaux of folk life to present an entertaining program.

Appearing in native costumes, the group of 15 performers directed by Juan Onalibia, presented a variety of numbers to give a well-rounded picture of life of the Basques, who inhabit a region of the Pyrenees Mountains, which separate Spain and France. Their musical accompaniment consisted of a drum, a three-holed flute called a Txistu, and an accordion. Opening selections included Basque choral music. The second part was a tableau of Basque country life, featuring both songs and native dances. The third part again featured choral music, and the final portion of the program included another tableau: Fiesta in a Basque Village. Unusual among the dancing selections were the flag, sword, stick and arch dances, which required considerable skill in their execution.

Featured dancers included Maria Beobide, who also gave the weird Basque mountain cry, and Jaime Castillo. The singing soloists were also commendable.

H-Bomb Could Wipe Out City, Strauss States

more attention to developing peacetime uses of atomic energy.

President Eisenhower listened with keen attention as Strauss—just back from the Pacific tests—read a four-page statement and then answered a few questions.

In reply to one question, Strauss said, without qualification, that an H-bomb large enough to "take out" a city can be made.

"How big a city?" he was asked. "Any city," Strauss replied.

"New York?" a reporter pressed. Strauss nodded and said, "the metropolitan area."

Strauss also used the word "de-roy" in describing what an H-bomb could do to the metropolitan area of New York.

Asked specifically after the news conference what he meant by the phrase "take out a city," Strauss said he meant "put a city out of commission, not level it."

Eisenhower himself said earlier there is some possibility the Russians are getting ready to talk business about a plan for international peacetime use of atomic energy.

He made this statement when asked what significance the government attaches to the recent publication by the Russians of some details of their atomic and H-weapon research.

rushed to the scene to assist local authorities.

The explosion occurred shortly before classes were due to be dismissed for the lunch hour. Nearby residents said it made a soft, booming sound and that flames rolled out of the building to a height of at least 50 feet.

A rescue worker told a newsman that the bodies were all found in one room of the building.

"It appeared that after the fire broke out, the children attempted to get out of the windows, since most of the bodies were near the window wall of the room," he said.
