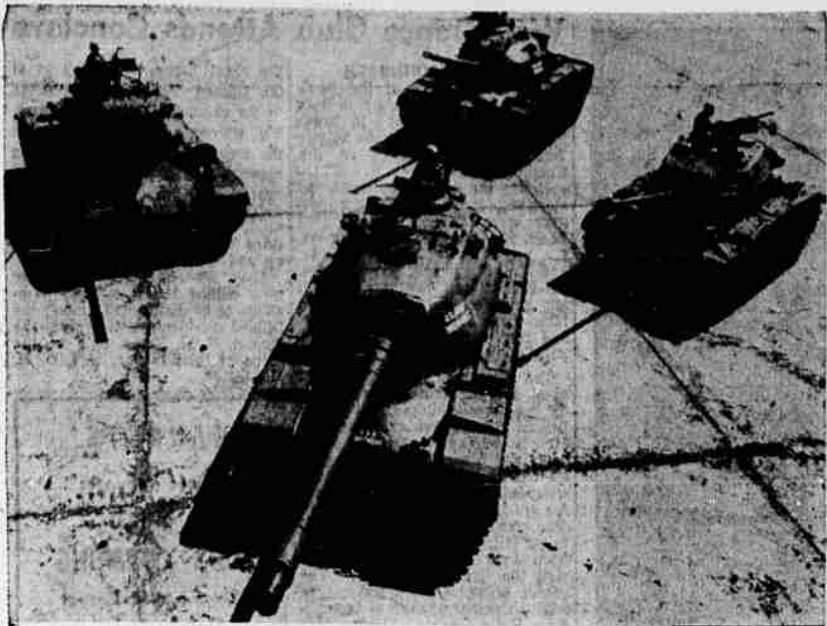

Oregon Civil Defense Alerted By Flood Threat
SALEM — The Oregon Civil Defense Agency announced Tuesday it has alerted civil defense agencies along the Lower Columbia River to cope with major flood conditions.
State Civil Defense Director Arthur M. Sheets said that if a major flood occurs, the disaster relief activity would involve the engineering services of drainage and diking districts, cities, counties, the state, Army Engineers, Red Cross, and medical and welfare organizations.
He said civil defense would direct all relief activities.

Australians Unwittingly Gave Spies Dope

CANBERRA, Australia — The Petrov spy documents list two and possibly three members of Australia's house of Representatives as having unwittingly given information to Soviet agents, the Royal Commission on Espionage was told.
The commission's counsel, W. J. Windeyer, made the revelation during preliminary hearings into the story of Russian spying in Australia told by Vladimir Petrov, former Soviet Embassy third secretary here who quit the Reds and was given political asylum.
The counsel said one of the documents turned over by Petrov related to American and Japanese interests in Australia. He said it was 37 pages long but did not disclose its contents.
He said one of the two members of Parliament definitely mentioned in the papers as unwitting informants was from the Liberal Country party government coalition and the other was from the opposition Labor faction.
He did not reveal their names or indicate the importance of the information the Soviets gleaned from what he termed unguarded remarks.
He also said government employees had passed information and copies of documents to agents of the Soviet MVD.

Film, Newspaper Truck Is Damaged By Blaze

ALBANY, Ore. — A truck loaded with movie film and Portland newspapers burst into flame south of here Monday night. The newspapers were destroyed but most of the film was saved.
Driver Carl Hess, Portland, said he noticed sparks coming from the rear of the truck. He pulled to the roadside as the truck started burning. He said sparks from the exhaust apparently ignited the fuel line.
The truck was en route to Cave Junction and Ashland with a load of Oregon Journals and Oregonians for delivery Tuesday morning. The newspapers had to print extra papers to replace the ones destroyed in the fire.
George McGreen of Oregon Film Service in Portland estimated the loss at \$4,500.
