West German Sovereignty Plans Pushed

LONDON (AP)—The United States and Britain are pushing ahead with plans to give West Germany almost full sovereignty—including rearmament powers—in their two occupation zones if France does not ratify the European army plan. Political and legal experts of the

two Allied nations opened meetings at the Foreign office Monday to draft a program of joint U. S.—British action to be launched if the European Defense Community is not set up soon. The conferences here are expected to conclude before the end of this week. Under study are proposals to:

French High Commission in Bonn and set up American and British embassies. Such action would leave the French zone, in southwest Germany, the sole occupied territory in the federal republic and would put the French under acute German pressure to get out of that.
