

Lumber Price Rise; Cascara Bark Goes Down

PORTLAND (AP) — Some lumber prices may go up because of the lumber strike, but the price of cascara bark is going down.

It happens every time the woods camps and mills close. The idle men go out to strip bark from cascara trees for cash.

The price for dry bark is down from 21 to 15 cents a pound. Green bark is down from 7 or 8 cents to a nickel.

Man, Ex-Wife Reunited During News Interview

NEWPORT NEWS, Va. (AP) — The soldier was telling of his rodeo experiences when a startled expression came over his face and he blurted out:

"It can't be true—it's my first wife."

A pause, then:

"My God, baby, I've searched all over the country for you."

And that's how a slim attractive proofreader and the husband she

had believed dead five years were reunited last night in the newsroom of the Newport News Daily Press, where the soldier was being interviewed.

The two, Mrs. Wayne Ferguson and Donald Eugene (Tex) Tinkle, had given up hope of ever seeing each other again and both since had remarried.

Mrs. Ferguson, 34, believed Tinkle was killed in a rodeo accident in 1949 at Camden, N.J. Tinkle, 25, now a soldier at nearby Ft. Eustis, obtained a divorce in Nevada in 1951 on grounds of desertion after two years of fruitless searching for her.

The two were separated in Roanoke, Va., in 1949 shortly after their daughter—whom he 5 years old Monday—was born and Tinkle

suffered a serious leg and ankle injury in a rodeo accident. Tinkle left his wife—then a trick rider—in Roanoke and went to Camden with the show.

"A few days after he left, I received a wire from Camden saying he had been killed in a bad rodeo accident," Mrs. Ferguson said. "He had been injured so badly so many times—I accepted it without question."

She remarried—an Air Force sergeant stationed at Langley Air Force Base—in 1951. They now have two children.

Another couple, not knowing Tinkle was married, took him in their trailer with the rodeo to Nova Scotia after the Camden mishap. He said there were blank spots in his memory but about six months

later he began to remember his past and returned to Roanoke to search for his wife.

Tinkle remarried last year and was drafted in November. His second wife is with him at Ft. Eustis. Mrs. Ferguson lives with her husband at nearby Warwick.

The two couples spent the evening together reminiscing and comparing notes of the last five years. Said Mrs. Ferguson:

"It's wonderful to see Tex again but we've both grown up and we've both taken up different ways of life. We wouldn't be happy going back together again. We're just so happy to see each other—all four of us."

Medford Boy Strangled By Rope From Tree

MEDFORD (AP) — A rope, used by children to swing from a tree, strangled 6-year-old Steven Robert Hawkins Thursday.

There were loops in the rope for the children to swing themselves up from the ground. The boy apparently lost his hold while swinging, and his head fell into a loop.

Daniel Sanger, also 6, at once called the boy's mother, but artificial respiration failed.

He was the son of Robert W. Hawkins, a Medford fireman.

Concrete Canal In India Opened

NANGAL DAM, India (AP) — Prime Minister Nehru Thursday opened India's new concrete and lined canal system, the world's largest project like it would "revolutionize the whole face of rural India within the next seven or eight years."

Nehru pressed a button opening the gates of Nangal Dam, 225 miles north of New Delhi in the Himalayan foothills. Waters of the Sutlej River gushed into the canals, which include one channel 240 miles long.

India is building a sprawling, 327 million dollar hydroelectric and irrigation project embracing the Nangal system and nearby Bhakra Dam without any foreign financial help.

Construction work on the Bhakra project is under the supervision of 66-year-old American dam builder Harvey Slocom. When finished, the 680-foot Bhakra Dam will be the second highest in the world, topped only by U.S.'s 726-foot Hoover Dam.

Nehru paid tribute today to Slocom, a salty engineer credited with building the Grand Coulee and Shasta dams in the United States.

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Full Separation Of Management Asked For School

SALEM (AP) — Complete separation of management of a proposed intermediate institution from that of the state boys' school and the prison, was recommended by Dr. Sanford Bates in a formal report to the Oregon Board of Control.

Dr. Bates, a New Jersey Penologist, has been employed as consultant on planning and administering the new institution for which the 1953 Legislature appropriated \$1,250,000.

Importance of keeping the distinction in the public mind that the institution is not primarily for punishment but is built around the concept that the men who go there still have a fair chance of being reclaimed, was emphasized by Dr. Bates in his report released Friday.

He suggested that the top official be called the superintendent rather than warden, and that a board of managers of five to seven people be set up.

Age should not be an exclusive factor in sentencing to the new institution, Dr. Bates asserted. "Some persons of 18 years are older in criminal ways than others 50 years," he said.

Dr. Bates also made these recommendations:

A sentence limitation, probably of five years.

Setting up a diagnostic center to determine to which institution an individual should be sent. In lieu of such a center, a joint classification procedure to confirm or amend the judge's decision after he has indicated to which institution they should go.

Provision for transfer between institutions where decision of the court is considered wrong.

Release from the new institution in the hands of the parole board, on recommendation only from institution heads.

He also suggested further consideration of a site in the south part of the county, 15 miles from Salem near Jefferson.

Toddler Drowns In Pool As Playmates Stand By

MEDFORD (AP) — A toddler drowned in a pool of water near here Friday while playmates stood by, apparently unaware that he was in danger.

The victim, James Alanson Lewis Jr., 2, was with two others including his brother Michael, 3, in quest of frogs near their rural home. He fell into a sump about 14 by 8 feet across and 3 or 4 feet deep.

The others seemed not to realize his plight but a 5-year-old child came by moments later and ran for help, which came too late.

It was the third accidental death of a little child in this area in three days. Stevens Hawkins, 6, strangled on a rope Thursday and Teresa Susan Rolis, 2, died Wednesday of what was thought to have been poisoning from quinine.
