Legion Battle Urged Against AMA Beliefs

NEW YORK (AP)—The National commander of the American Legion called on Legionnaires to "fight" the American Medical Assn. on behalf of hospital and medical benefits for veterans.

The commander, Arthur J. Connell, of Middletown, Conn., told New York State Legionnaires the AMA is participating in an "anti-veteran crusade."

"As long as the AMA is throwing down the gauntlet to the veterans of this nation, let's pick it up," Connell said.

The AMA has argued for years that some Veterans Administration hospitals and medical services were superfluous and should be trimmed. The Legion has contended they are necessary.

Connell said he was gratified at "support given us by individual doctors, members of the AMA who resent and oppose their leadership's effort to cripple the present veterans' hospital program."
