

House Approves Measure For Repair Of Vessels

WASHINGTON (AP)—The House today approved a Senate-House compromise authorizing \$25 million for the repair, modernization and conversion of merchant vessels in the reserve fleet. Conferees accepted the House figure instead of the higher \$45-million authorization provided in the Senate-passed revision of the bill.

They also struck out of the bill Senate provisions to include Great Lakes and inland waterways ship-repair yards in the defense-modernization program. The compromise applies only to Atlantic, Pacific and Gulf coast yards.

Big Steel Bridge Spans Shifted

KENNEWICK, Wash. (AP)—Construction workers switched 3,300,000-pound steel bridge spans over the Columbia River here Monday like a racetrack mechanic swapping tires.

The two spans, nearly as long as a city block, and as high as a four-story building, were traded in an operation taking slightly more than four hours. Connecting and finishing work took another eight hours and trains were running over the bridge by late afternoon.

The span shift is part of a \$16 million dollar renovating project on the Northern Pacific railway bridge made necessary to provide clearance over McNary reservoir backwaters.

In earlier projects which have been going on since 1952, concrete piers were built downstream from the old bridge and six other spans were raised

New Security System Ordered By President

WASHINGTON (AP)—A new system of checking on what happens to the case of a government worker flagged as a possible security risk was ordered into effect late last week by President Eisenhower.

The order requires each department and agency head to report to the Civil Service Commission "as soon as possible" what action has been taken in suspected security cases.

In cases where a "full field investigation" is made, the report must be made no later than 90 days after receipt of the final report. A full field investigation is one made on an employee or official after a preliminary inquiry turns up derogatory information against him.

The order directs the Civil Service Commission to report to the National Security Council, headed by Eisenhower, what action is taken by the government agencies and to take special note of any delay "in taking timely action under this order."

They were married here June 22 by Justice of the Peace J. E. Haney, reported Charlton County Ordinary (probate judge) Cecil Conner, custodian of marriage records.

The couple meanwhile was reported to have settled down to a domestic life in New York's Bronx while awaiting the outcome of state's efforts to make Jelke's conviction two years ago on compulsory prostitution charges stick.
