Many Strikers Obtaining Other Jobs; Business Feels Economic Pinch Of Layoff

A large percentage of striking lumber workers in Douglas County have obtained other temporary employment and are awaiting settlement of strikes, George T. Foster believes.
 The Roseburg manager of the State Employment Service said

that at the end of July about 1,100 persons in the county were affected directly by the strikes. Two hundred fifty, he said, returned to work during the month.
 The figure since has been reduced to about 910 during the early days of this month.
 The strike has had a fringe effect on smaller mills in the county. They have been taking advantage of higher lumber prices to increase production by working as many hours as possible.
 Aside from the mills involved in the labor disputes, Foster said, the Roseburg area apparently is at its peak for employment at the present time.

Business Conditions Slow
 He explained: Business conditions are slow, which has resulted in fewer persons being employed. The bean harvest is in full swing and no serious troubles in securing pickers has been encountered as yet. The majority of the openings that become available from time to time are of replacement in nature rather than new jobs.
 Foster said retail and wholesale trade has felt the effects of income losses. He said the fact has been indicated from employers by the field.
 The effect may be prolonged. Foster foresees far-reaching economic consequences in the inability of some lumber firms to cold deck enough logs for a full winter's consumption.
 The total of unemployed persons in the county didn't increase during July, Foster related. Estimates of the number of unemployed, which included those on strike, dropped about 20 per cent from June.

Unemployment Above 1953
 Exclusive of those involved in labor disputes, the unemployed totals are about 70 per cent higher than for the same period last year. This condition Foster attributed largely to the beginning of a new unemployment benefit year and the slowdown of business conditions resulting from the strike.
 Those looking for jobs, said the employment manager, will find available job openings are steadily decreasing in number as the lumber strike is prolonged. When the matter is settled, the general belief is that many jobs will become available, he explained.
 At the present time, there is a demand for bean pickers and a few openings in semi-skilled occupations in the construction and lumber industries.
 The bean harvest will be followed by the picking of pears, prunes and walnuts, but those activities won't require a large number of workers to get the job done.

Reserve Officers Free Insurance Given Approval

WASHINGTON — The Senate passed and sent to the White House Wednesday a bill under which reserve officers of the Army, Navy and Air Force would be covered by \$10,000 free insurance while on active duty for 14 days or more.
 It also would permit them to apply after 30 days of duty for national service life insurance.
 In other action dealing with the military services and veterans,

the Senate passed and sent to the President:
 A measure providing a 5 per cent increase of veterans compensation for certain service connected disability cases.
 A bill providing for the erection of markers in national cemeteries to commemorate servicemen missing in action whose bodies have never been found.
 A bill boosting from \$500 to \$700 yearly federal aid for states for

war veterans hospitalized in state homes.
 Legislation designed to allow private firms doing business with the government to employ fleet admirals no longer on actual active duty.
 Technically fleet admirals and generals of the army never retire from active duty. They remain on the active list with full pay and allowances.
 An old law prevents payment of

service pay to any naval officer on a company furnishing supplies to the active list who is employed by the government.

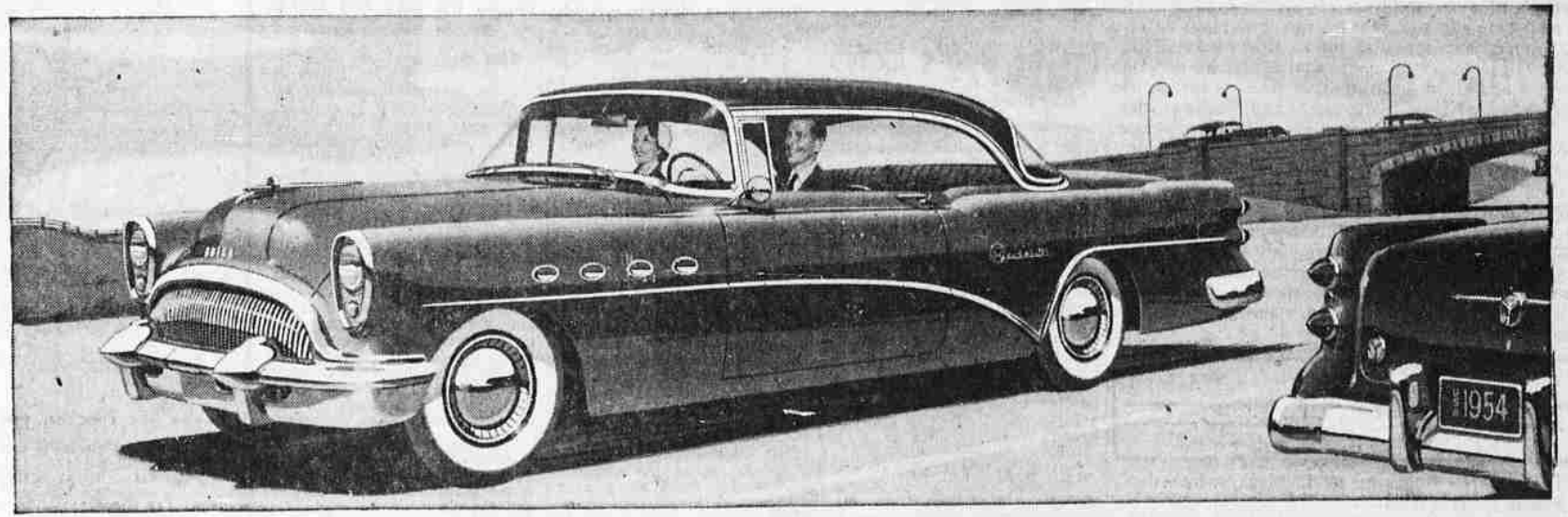
