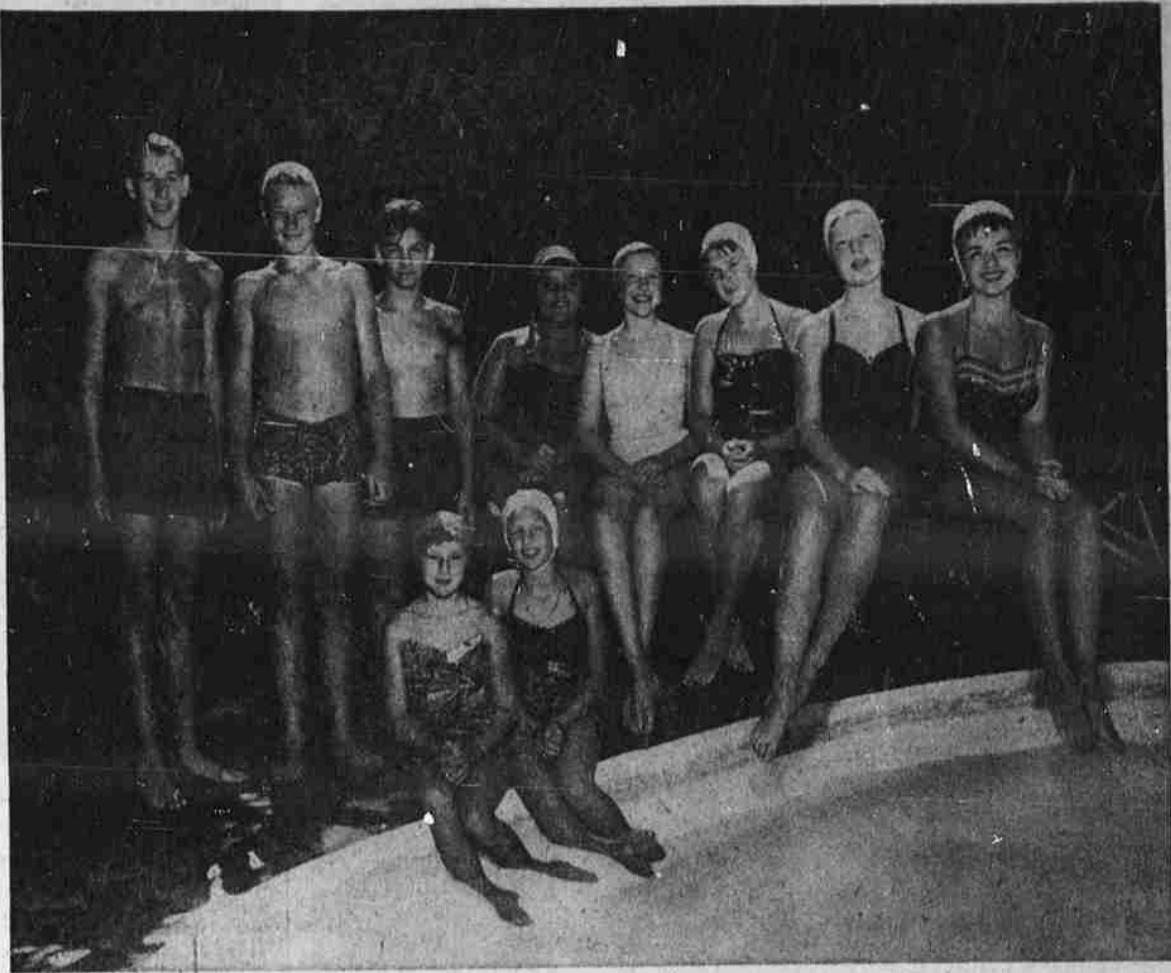


# LET'S SWIM

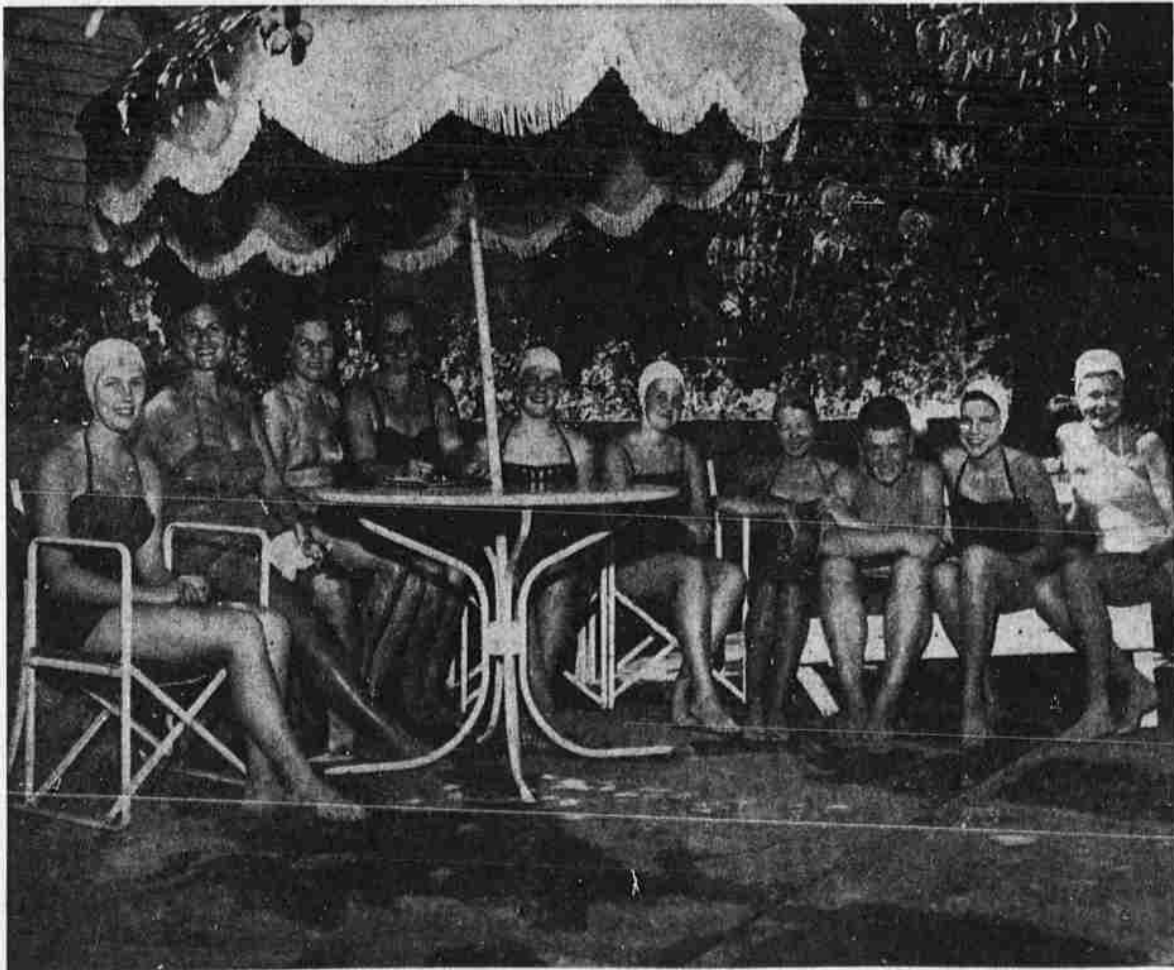
