It continued, evidence of assays received from the company are entirely missing from the files in the case.

The letter went on to say that a search had been made of the file by Bureau of Land Management personnel and "further search by a representative from any office failed to reveal any of the correspondence between the regional office and applicant concerning receipt of assay reports or the assay reports themselves."

In the letter, Ellsworth cites a letter from Elmer M. H. McDonald, Jr., secretary-treasurer of the Serena company. He quotes the letter from Hattan as saying as results were incorporated in a report. "The file does not disclose a single one of the assay reports," Ellsworth's letter says.

Ellsworth's letter goes on to say the applicant filed evidence of mineralization three times, but papers "either were never placed in the file or were removed there after. The letter continues that the matter came to hearing in evidence, accepting evidence of contest (the Forest Service) and suppressing evidence of contest (Serena company)."

If such action is willful, the letter said, it "would constitute fraud," depriving applicant of "substantial legal right to have evidence considered." He called it "prejudicial to any fair decision." He said any action taken "in absence of such data cannot result in any semblance of justice." The letter called the "record as it stands... a sham and a deceit."

Concluding, the Ellsworth letter asked the government to remedy the situation by making the record whole by uncovering the missing mineralization reports and other papers.

The letter requested the department (of Interior) to "defer further action and decision on the case" until applicant's evidence is secured.

Ellsworth's letter made no specific proposal for carrying out the recommendation, but asked that some plan be worked out "which will not compound injustice."

In person, Ellsworth said the papers were recovered after the above letter was written. He said, however, that despite their reappearance in the files of the Dept. of Interior, another assay was ordered by Davis. He said it was on the basis of the last assay that the patent was granted.

part of the development stage. He said a quarter of a million dollars had been spent in development.

McDonald said that not only had the Dept. of Interior's Clarence Davis approved the patent application, but the approval was recorded by the Oregon State Dept. of Geology and Mineral Resources.

He also rebutted Porter's claim that one of the engineers selected by the Dept. of Interior was the builder of the Serena mine in the Rogue River National Forest.

He said the engineer, Ford McCormick, had not built the mine. He said McCormick was and was a member of the State Board of Examining Engineers and "beyond reproach."

He said the other engineer, in cooperation with McCormick, at the request of the Dept. of Interior was R. N. Appling of the Bureau of Mines. He said Appling supervised the job. It was on the basis of their report that patent rights were granted, McDonald said.

McDonald explained that only 15 of the 23 claims had been patented. They involved 292 acres of the 454 acres. The other eight were approved without controversy, he said.

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Total School Enrollment
In County Increases 1,093

Total county school enrollment figures just compiled show a 7.6 per cent gain over last year, according to W. M. Campbell, deputy county superintendent.

Eighteen county schools have increased enrollment, many of them sizeable ones, and seven schools show decreases.

The total enrollment for the county's elementary and high schools is 15,561, compared to 14,468 last year, or a gain of 1,093.

Roseburg district, naturally enough, has the biggest increase, 230, and a new high total of 4,883.

Of the total, 3,648 are elementary students and 1,235 are in high school.

The next largest gain was in the Dillard district which added 171 for a total of 1,286. Big gains were also shown in Myrtle Creek and Oakland districts, 155 and 153 respectively. Ash district, with 27

pupils, was the only one unchanged.

Biggest drop in enrollment was at Elkton, with 21. Yoncalla elementary lost 15, and Drain high lost 11.

Over a four-year period, there has been a gain of 38.1 per cent, with 4,298 more students now than in 1950. Past totals were: 1950, 11,263; 1951, 12,135; 1952, 13,424; 1953, 14,468.

Crewman Aboard Storm Hunting Plane Injured

MIAMI, Fla. — Violent turbulence in hurricane Hazel Friday injured a crewman aboard a Navy storm hunting plane.

The hurricane, hurling 115-mile winds around its well-defined eye, has become so turbulent that the Navy pilot radioed "No further operations advised."

Hazel, eighth tropical storm of the season, then was centered about latitude 13.5 north, longitude 71.4 west, or about 100 miles due north of the Gulf of Venezuela on the southern coast of the Caribbean Sea. It was about 1,000 miles southeast of Florida.

The radio report from the plane gave no details of the injury to the crewman and did not identify him. A crew of 10 was on board.

After penetrating the eye, the crew emerged and headed for the naval base at Guantanamo Bay, Cuba.

Grady Norton, chief storm forecaster at Miami, said Hazel "is getting to be a very severe storm."

It continued to move almost due west, but its forward motion had slowed down to less than 10 miles an hour.

Rare Crane Believed Spotted Near Olalla

One of the last of the nation's whooping cranes was believed to have been seen in the Olalla-Tenmile
