43 Hunting Accidents Oregon Season's Total
PORTLAND - So far this year there have been 43 hunting accidents in Oregon, the State Game Commission reported.

Before the main hunting season started there had been two deaths and three wounding.

On Oct. 23, the day the pheasant season opened, 10 hunters were wounded. That was the season's peak for careless spraying of shot.

Seven hunters were killed during the deer season.

All big game hunting now is ended except for controlled seasons, three of which are for elk and one for deer. However, waterfowl seasons extend into next year, and the commission warned in a statement that past records show some careless shooting by waterfowl hunters.
