Rose PTA To Meet — Rose School PTA will meet tonight at 8 o'clock and all members are urged to attend.

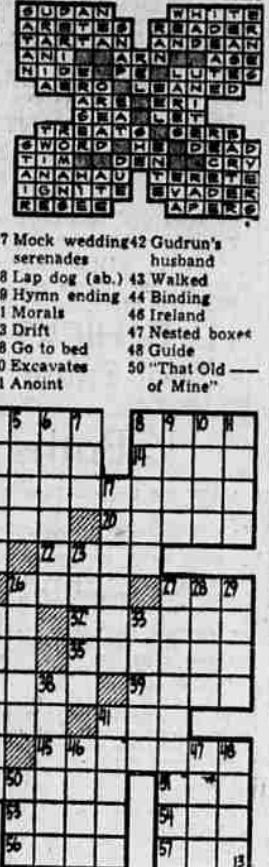
