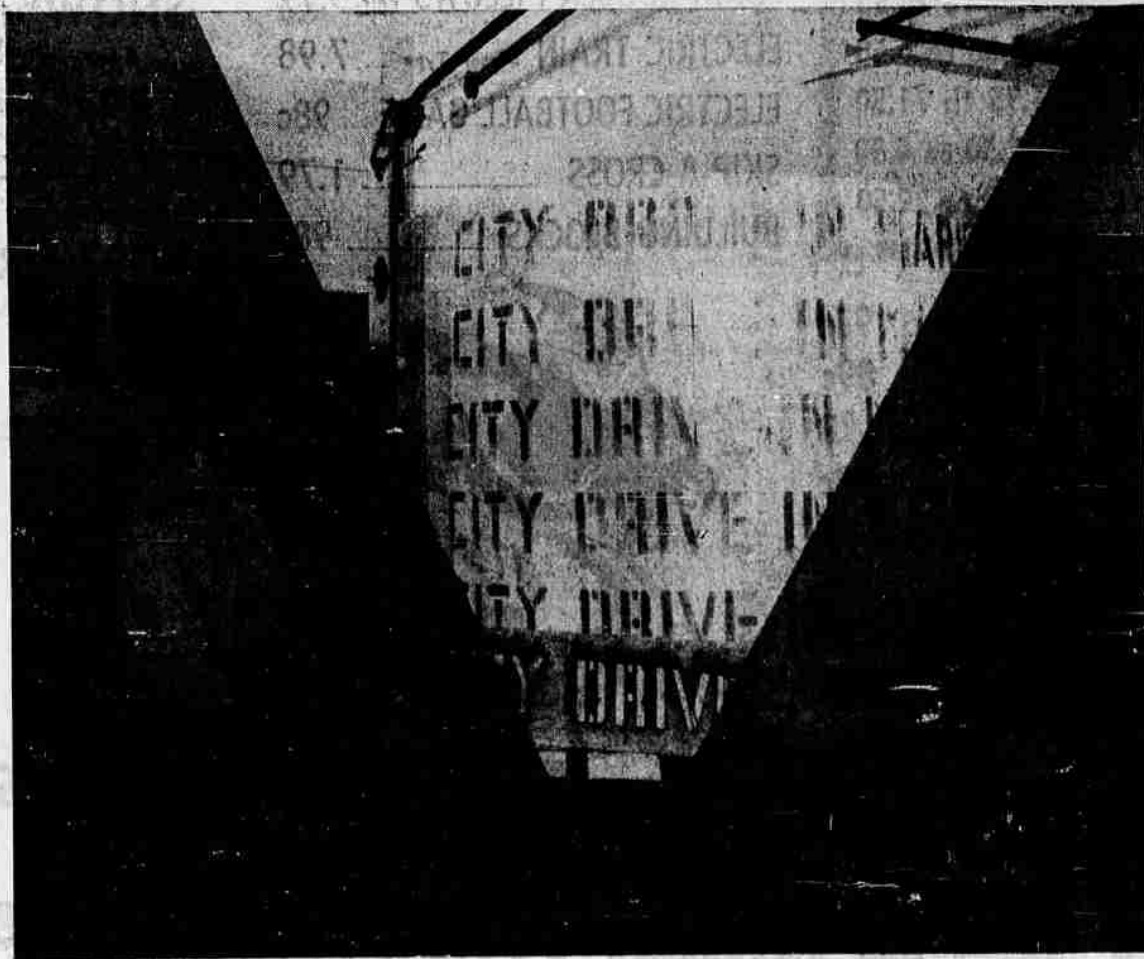


YES SIR CITY DRIVE DOES IT AGAIN

More than two and a half tons of fine well aged American Cheddar in one piece--from the heart of Wisconsin's Dairyland - - that's what the cheese lovers of Roseburg, Oregon, are going to have the opportunity to see and buy at the City Drive-In Market during the store's forthcoming Cheese Festival. This Mammoth Cheddar Cheese, created especially for City Drive-In by Steve Siudzinski of Denmark, Wisconsin, will be the center of a display which will include all kinds, sizes and shapes of cheese for every purpose in modern cooking. How big is a 2½-ton cheese? Well, it stands nearly five feet high, and is six feet in diameter. Another way to describe it is that 5,000 pounds of cheese will provide about 75,000 sandwiches.
