

Trailer Parking Slated For Check Anent Sanitation

Numerous complaints have been received by the Douglas County Health Dept. regarding the parking of individual trailers.

Sanitarian Irv Reiersen, who is responsible for the tourist park and travelers' accommodations program in the county, states that individual parking of trailers does not come under the county's jurisdiction as far as licensing is concerned.

However, individual trailers are considered by the health department as homes and must install the necessary sanitary facilities comparable to any house. This

calls for sewer hook-ups or installation of sub-surface drainage systems.

Reiersen announced that a county-wide check-up on such trailers will be made early in 1955.

"The indiscreet parking of trailers in Douglas County without the necessary sanitary facilities must be curtailed, since this constitutes a definite health hazard," Reiersen stated. "Such parking of trailers have three alternatives," Reiersen said: "Apply for a trailer park license, install a code sewer

age system, or move into an approved trailer park."

Reiersen also explained that the existing law does not require timber or agriculture workers to be licensed, but the sanitary facilities must still be installed.

Prehistoric Human Skull Yields Teeth

TOKYO (U) — Peiping Radio disclosed Monday that Chinese scientists have found a couple more teeth of Peking man, who inhabited the earth about 500,000 years ago.

A broadcast said Dr. Young Chung-Chien, paleontologist with the Chinese Academy of Sciences, made a report on Peking man discoveries at a gathering of scientists in Peiping Monday on the 25th anniversary of the discovery of the first skull bones.

Dr. Young said that since 1949, scientists exploring the site of the original discovery had found five teeth and two bone fragments.

Peiping in February of 1953 announced that three teeth and some bone fragments had been unearthed.

The site of the Peking man discoveries is Choukoutien, 30 miles southwest of Peiping.

Japanese Socialists Hit Arms Aid Via U.S.

TOKYO (U) — Japan's two Socialist parties announced Monday they will fight "rearmament through American aid."

The right and left wing Socialists unveiled a platform also calling for disarmament by major powers including the United States and Russia, eventual universal disarmament, international control of atomic energy and diplomatic relations with Red China and Russia.

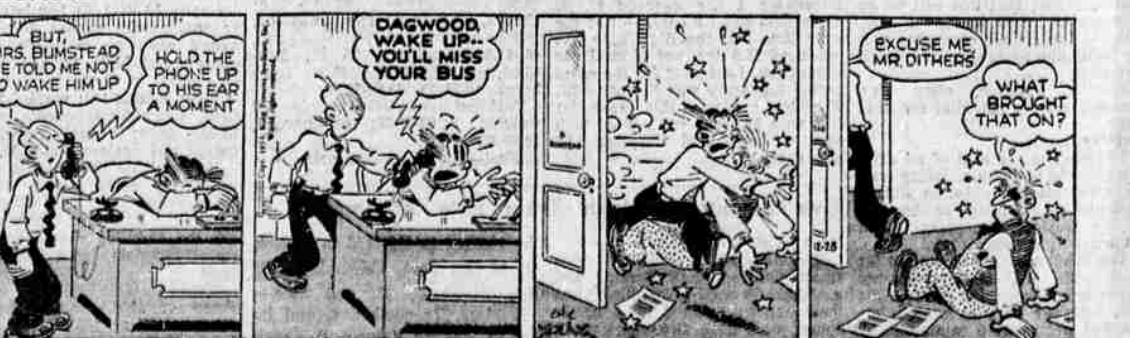

EXPLOSION STARTS FIRE

TUCSON, Ariz. (U) — Damage estimated at \$500,000 was caused early Monday when fire followed a gas explosion in the basement of the Paulos restaurant.

The one story restaurant in the heart of the city was completely destroyed. The bar had closed at 11:30 p.m. about 15 minutes before the explosion and the place was empty. No one was injured.

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Military Pay Increases Aimed At Technicians

WASHINGTON (U) — Asst. Secretary of Defense Fred Seaton says administration proposals for military pay raises would not affect the ordinary private but would aim at keeping skilled technicians in uniform.

Seaton said Congress will be asked to approve pay hikes on "a selective basis" for men who—particularly in the Air Force—require considerable training or have special skills.

In an interview, Seaton listed proposals to improve overseas housing and medical aid for dependents.
