

Student Skiers Retrace Steps; Locate Searchers

CORVALLIS (AP) — Two Oregon State College skiers, lost overnight on Mary's Peak, retraced their steps Thursday morning and found a rescue party. They were unhurt.

Tyrell G. Lowry, 22, a senior from Portland, and Richard D. Gilbert Jr., 20, a junior, also from Portland, missed a turn without being aware of it while coming down the peak Wednesday afternoon and soon were lost.

But, they told rescuers, they continued on down past the snow line to open timber, built a fire and spent the night beside it. Then, when dawn came, they retraced their steps to the top of the peak

knowing that in good weather they could find their way down it.

When they got to the top at mid-morning, there were a dozen of their fraternity brothers from Sigma Alpha Epsilon to greet them.

Lowry, in good shape, skied down to where sheriff's deputies waited near where the missing skiers had parked their car. Gilbert, conceding that he was pretty well fagged out, was helped down. The two then drove back to the campus in Lowry's car after first eating a cup of coffee from the deputies.

The two agreed they were wor-

ried when they finally decided, at about 4:30 p. m. Wednesday, they were lost. But both were experienced in skiing—Gilbert heads the OSC ski team—and they decided then on their plan of spending the night by a fire below the snow line.

Retracing their steps up the steep slopes of the peak—the highest in the Coast Range at 4,097 feet—was tiring and they were hungry, too, they said, but otherwise all right.

An elaborate search plan had been worked out by sheriff's officers in case they were not found soon.
