EDINBURGH, Scotland, (AP) — Sedate and academic Edinburgh, usually the best behaved of cities, woke up Thursday to read a sign in glaring yellow letters standing four feet high saying: "Get out Limey Lizzie."

The sign was painted along a 25-foot section of garden wall at Holyrood House. That is the lovely palace where Mary Queen of Scots lived and where Queen Elizabeth II and the Duke of Edinburgh will take up residence for a week in June.

In Edinburgh there was little doubt who "Limey Lizzie" might be. Lizzie is short for Elizabeth and Limey is an English person. Queen Elizabeth fits the bill.

Superintendent Edward Ferrier, chief of the Edinburgh criminal investigation division, ordered a crew to wash the sign away. Just after dawn the job was finished except for a tell tale smudge of yellow and an investigation got under way.

Officers said "either it was the work of irresponsible youths or extremists in the Scottish nationalist movement."

Selling Liquor To Minors Under 21 Still Illegal

PORTLAND (AP) — The State Liquor Commission is reminding its licensees that it still is illegal to sell liquor to anyone under 21.

A commission spokesman said this mailed reminder is going to all licensees because a Portland municipal judge recently refused to punish an 18-year-old woman convicted of buying an alcoholic drink. The judge said in Oregon law a married person is regarded as having reached his or her majority.

The spokesman said liquor control laws nevertheless specify that a person cannot buy liquor until 21 years old.

Two Imprisoned Communists Offer Uncle Sam Deal

NEW YORK (AP) — Two imprisoned Communist conspiracy leaders have offered Uncle Sam a deal—set us free and we'll leave the country.

The pair—Jacob Mindel, 74, and Claudia Jones, 40, spurned a federal judge's proposal two years ago to suspend sentence if they wanted to go to Russia.

They did not specify in their plea Wednesday where they would go if their sentences were reduced to the time already served.

U. S. Judge Edward J. Dimock, who imposed sentence, will hear arguments on the offer next Monday.

Counsel for the pair, Mrs. Mary M. Kaufman, made the proposal in federal court. She said they have heart ailments and continued confinement would endanger their lives.

Mindel, born in Russia, became a naturalized American citizen in 1918. Serving as a member of the American Communist Party's national education commission, he was sentenced to two years in prison and fined \$4,000.

Miss Jones, a British subject from the West Indies, faces deportation at the end of her prison sentence. Serving as secretary of the Communist Party's women's commission, she was sentenced to one year and fined \$2,000.

The two — along with the rest of the dozen second-string Communist leaders convicted — started to serve time Jan. 11 after the U. S. Supreme Court refused to review their case.

Chiang Wouldn't Oppose Cease Fire Resolution

NEW YORK (AP) — The New York Herald Tribune said today that the U. S. government has received assurances from Generalissimo Chiang Kai-shek that his government will not veto or otherwise oppose any reasonable cease-fire resolution in the United Nations Security Council.

A Washington dispatch to the newspaper said the assurances became known as the Senate opened debate on a resolution authorizing President Eisenhower to use force if necessary to defend Formosa and the Pescadores.

Miss Monroe, staying at another hotel, could not be reached for comment.

Officers Probing Mysterious Case Of Disappearance

SPOKANE (AP) — Sheriff's officers continued their investigation Wednesday of the mysterious case of Anthony M. Marx who turned up in Seattle after he was presumed drowned in the Spokane River last week.

Marx, 43, a garage owner and the father of five children, told officers he must have been slugged and robbed but remembers nothing that happened from Thursday afternoon until Monday night.

Prosecutor Hugh Evans said a physician who examined Marx found no evidence he had suffered a blow on the head.

Marx' English-made car was pulled from the river Thursday and it was believed his body had been washed downstream. The search was abandoned Monday. That night he called his wife from Seattle to say he couldn't remember anything after picking up a hitch hiker while on a service call northwest of the city last Thursday.

He flew back here Tuesday still wearing his garage overalls. He said \$900 he had in a wallet was missing but that he still had \$300 and his wrist watch. He said he "came to" in a Seattle hotel.

He went home after questioning Tuesday.

Young Man Risks Life To Save His Landlord

PORTLAND (AP) — The interior of the house was in flames when 19-year-old Alvin Stormo learned his landlord was inside.

Twice Stormo tried to get inside to rescue 78-year-old August Pederson, and twice he had to run back from the heat Wednesday.

Finally he threw a wet blanket over his head, and made it inside. He found Pederson lying on the floor, and dragged him outside.

Pederson, who owns the house and the nearby one where Stormo lives, suffered some burns, but hospital attendants said his condition was good. Stormo was not injured.

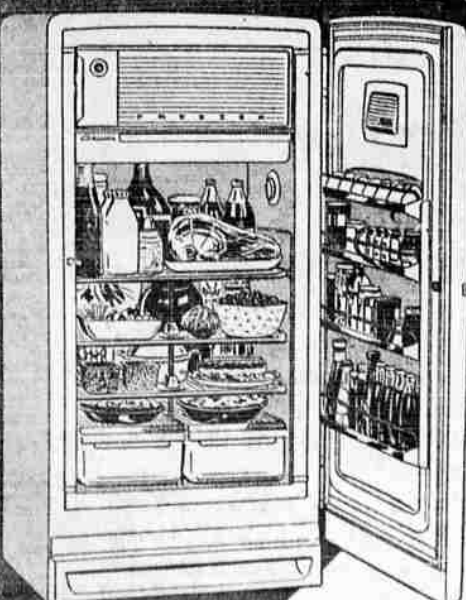
