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Mystery Vitamin May Become New Wonder Drug

NEW YORK (AP) — A mystery "vitamin" which may become a new wonder drug was described to a scientific conference here.

It promises benefits in treating some heart conditions, rheumatic fever and polio, and in preventing miscarriages.

It is hesperidin, also called Vitamin P, although scientists aren't certain it is a true vitamin.

Vitamin P or hesperidin is found in the peel and pulp of lemons and oranges and certain other foods. You don't get much of it from drinking fruit juices. It is available in prescription tablet form.

When combined with vitamin C, hesperidin strengthens the walls of tiny blood vessels or capillaries. Various illnesses seem to weaken these blood vessels, permitting blood fluids to leak out, and that perhaps favors the spread of disease germs.

The capillary-strengthening effect of hesperidin plus vitamin C is the basis for hopes this drug will have important medical uses. It's estimated that a person weighing 150 pounds has 60,000 or more miles of capillaries.

More than a dozen scientists reported on hesperidin at a conference sponsored by the New York Academy of Sciences.

Tablets containing both chemicals prevented dangerous or troublesome bleeding in patients taking blood-thinning drugs for treatment of coronary thrombosis and other blood vessel troubles, said Dr. Charles E. Brambel, Mercy Hospital, Baltimore.

The blood-thinning drugs are given to prevent formation of new blood clots. Heretofore about five per cent of patients have developed little hemorrhages from those drugs.

Edison Company Announces Plans For Atomic Plant

NEW YORK (AP) — Consolidated Edison Co., of New York, is about to announce plans for construction of the nation's first atomic power plant relying mainly on private financing, it was learned here.

An electric industry source said that Consolidated Edison will build a 100,000 to 200,000 kilowatt plant fired by nuclear fuels. Announcement of the plans was expected when Hudson R. Searing, the utility's president, testifies before the Joint Congressional Atomic Energy Committee in Washington.

Representatives of the company in New York said there would be no comment until after Searing had appeared before the committee this week.

Consolidated Edison previously had said it asked major producers of atomic power equipment to design and offer prices for the construction of a 200,000 kilowatt atomic power plant.

Last November the company purchased a former amusement park site on the Hudson River, south of Peekskill, N. Y., which an official said "might be suitable" for an atomic plant.

The country's first commercial atomic power plant is being built at Shippingport, Pa., by the Atomic Energy Commission and the Duquesne Light Co., Pittsburgh. This will be a 60,000 kilowatt plant.

The AEC is contributing a portion of the costs as part of the reactor development program, and Duquesne Light will pay AEC for the steam the reactor produces.

The Consolidated Edison plan was said to call for fully commercial operation. All the company would want from the federal government would be the right to purchase or lease from it the fuel, which only the government can own.

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
