

Employment Picture Takes On Brighter Outlook Than That Year Ago, Says Foster

Both present and future were considerably brighter than at the same time last year in the employment picture, according to George T. Foster, manager of the Roseburg office of the Oregon State Employment Service.

For the present, Foster pointed out that estimates of persons in the Roseburg area were approximately 40 per cent higher than for January 1954. He related that claims for unemployment insurance increased about 11 per cent over December but were more than 35 per cent less than for the same period last year.

Foster continued that although there was a slight increase in claimants for insurance over December, a decrease was noted from the January totals of last year, apparently because winter has not been too severe. Few federal employee claims have been filed since the first of the year.

Logging operations are being affected by snow at higher elevations, and some are down until spring. Others are operating only spasmodically. Sawmills and other wood manufacturing plants, however, have been able to operate at a fairly consistent rate. Foster credited this as a factor largely responsible for increased totals of employment over last year. Construction continues steady, but re-

tail trade activity suffered a slight letdown in the post-Christmas season.

Foster described the employment prospects for the future as "exceptionally good." An upswing is expected when weather conditions improve. He said considerable building construction is in the blueprint stage, and road-building should resume on a full-scale basis with warm weather. Foster said construction is expected to take an upswing in the next 60 days. Retail trade, he said, should recover soon.

At present, Foster announced, a large number of well-qualified workers are available in almost any category.

About 100,000 Americans are employed in waterworks.

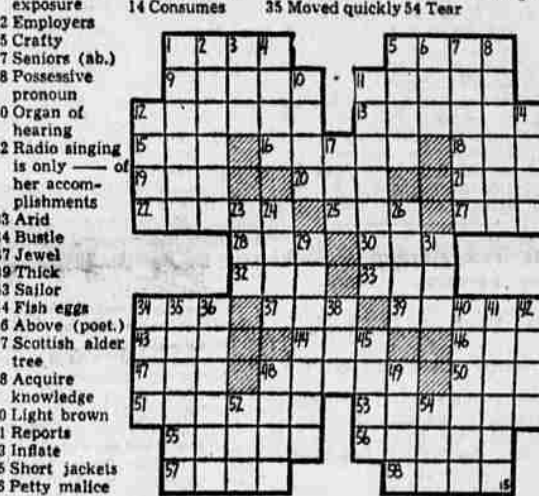
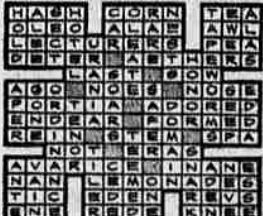

Foster-Parents Left Waiting

SEATTLE (AP)—An 11-year-old Korean boy apparently missed airplane connections in Tokyo and left his foster-parents-to-be waiting at a Seattle airport Saturday.

The Reid Garbers of Elmira, Ore., disappointed at the failure of Yun Han Goo to make the Northwest Airlines plane which arrived early Saturday, went back home but will return Monday. This time the orphan boy should be aboard.

The Garbers were looking forward to the arrival of this second Korean orphan whose adoption stems from the military service of their other sons in Korea. They worked for more than a year to arrange his entry into this country under the refugee act.

Sgt. Rex R. Gilman, himself an adopted son of the Garbers, met the boy in Korea in 1952 and laid the groundwork for his addition to the Garber family. The sergeant now is stationed at Ft. Lewis, Wash.

The Garbers' first adopted Korean son, Lee, was brought to this country in September, 1953, after becoming friends with Aaron, the Garbers' real son, in war-torn South Korea. Lee now is in the second grade in Elmira. Aaron
