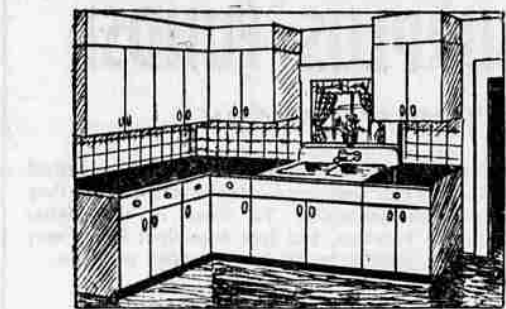


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New Open Bible Church At Glide

A new church has been opened in Glide with the Rev. Kenneth Thompson as pastor. The Church of the Open Bible occupies the building formerly known as the Glide Logging Supply, next to the Chevron service station.

The Rev. Mr. Thompson graduated from the Bible Standard Institute at Eugene in 1951, was married after graduation and the couple moved to Goldbar, Wash.,

where the Rev. Mr. Thompson accepted his first pastorate. After two years, he was transferred to Fair Oaks, Calif., and was resident pastor for 1½ years.

The Rev. Clarence Anderson, district supervisor and pastor of the Roseburg Church of the Open Bible, was instrumental in the Rev. Thompson's move to Oregon to establish a church at Glide. Sunday School is held Sundays at 10 a.m. and evening service at 8 p.m. There is no Sunday morning service. The Rev. Mr. Thompson holds a cottage Bible study class Thursday evenings at 7:30 p.m. at his home on the Frazier property. He is employed during the week at the Glide Lumber Co.

Highway Commission Lists Traffic Delays

SALEM (AP) — The Oregon Highway Commission listed the following routes Monday as being in below normal condition:

Pacific Highway — Construction for 4 miles north of Myrtle Creek; possible minor delay; bridge construction 2.4 miles south of Roseburg; possible minor delay.

Coast Highway — 5 miles gravel surface north of Gardiner; 2.45 miles detour on old pavement Clear Lake to Eel Lake; construction between 2 and 15 miles south of Port Orford; possible minor delay; 1.3 miles gravel surface Depoe Bay to Whale Cove.

Umpqua Highway — Construction for 1.4 miles east of Reedsport; minor delays.

Canyonville Using New Hospital Wing

The new addition to Canyonville's Forest Glen Hospital, although not quite finished, has been used for almost two weeks, adding 16 beds to make a total of 24 in that facility.

Hi-Fi Used
A separate entrance to the hospital, eliminating the necessity of going through the clinic, leads first to the new business manager's office and then to the new nurses' station. Featuring soft coral and chaise longue in the color scheme, the lobby will be accented with planters and indirect lighting. A high fidelity sound system will play recordings continuously. Speakers are in the ceiling of the hall.

Besides the new nurses' station and work room, and manager's office, there is a new pediatric ward and a new nursery. Soft pastels decorate each room with wall paper on one wall of each room—animal paper is featured in the pediatric ward.

Robert Fisher of Grants Pass is the architect, William Bom and Frank Allen of Canyonville are the builders. George Brinkworth, Canyonville, is the decorator. The staff of Forest Glen Hospital includes Dr. R. L. Falk, Dr. J. P. Aaronson, Dr. R. M. Varrelman, D. L. Daniels, business manager, and Floy Bailey, R.N., supervisor.

Reedsport Mayor Names Group To Help Vet's Widow

Reedsport Mayor Roy Henderson has appointed a committee of 10 prominent citizens to urge adequate compensation for the widow and children of a three-decorated World War II hero who died recently.

The soldier was Riley Lester Yarbrough of Reedsport, who died of a heart attack. He left a widow and two young sons.

Despite serious wounds on three occasions, he had been allotted a 10 per cent disability, or \$17 per month.

Mixed-up x-ray plates will probably be the basis of committee action. A letter will be sent to Oregon's delegation in Congress through Rep. Harris Ellsworth.

THE Port Umpqua Courier, Reedsport, quotes Dr. Courtney as saying he believes there was a mistake in handling of Yarbrough's records. Thompson, who served with Yarbrough in the 7th Infantry, and others who knew him well, said Yarbrough believed x-rays on his wounds had been mixed up, but that he was "just one of those quiet guys who didn't know how to put up a squawk for himself."

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
