Korean Veterans Bill Voted Back To Tax Committee

SALEM (AP) — The Oregon House of Representatives voted 40 to 19 this week to send the Korean Veterans

Committee, an action described by supporters of the bonus as an attempt to let it die.

The measure, which would be referred to the people, was before the House with a recommendation from the Joint Ways and Means Committee that it be defeated.

The maximum bonus would be \$800, computed at the rate of \$10 monthly for domestic service, and \$15 for each month of overseas service. The same bonus was paid to World War II veterans.

Rep. Charles A. Tom, Rufus Republican, opened the debate with the motion to send it to the Tax Committee, of which he is a member. He said it would cost \$11,000,000, and the Tax Committee should be allowed to look at it.

Dismissal Denied Of Charge Made Against Travis

DENVER (AP) — A defense motion to dismiss an indictment charging Maurice B. Travis with filing false non-Communist affidavits with the National Labor Relations Board was rejected in U. S. District Court this week.

Under pressure from locals, Travis resigned last month as secretary of the International Union of Mine, Mill & Smelter Workers (Ind.).

His lawyers asked dismissal of a six-count indictment returned by a federal grand jury on grounds that the non-Communist oath required of union officers is contrary to the Constitution; that charges should have been returned in Washington rather than in Denver; Travis' home and that of the union; that the grand jury was illegally selected; and that the indictment failed to state a crime.

Dis. Judge Jean S. Breitenstein said in a 22-page ruling that the Supreme Court already has held the non-Communist oath to be proper.

Because Travis' affidavits were made, executed and mailed here, selection of Denver as a trial site was both logical and legal, Breitenstein ruled.

Power Shortage Will Be Eased By Agreement

WASHINGTON (AP) — Recurring Pacific Northwest power shortages would be eased by connecting the Bonneville Power Administration system and the Idaho Power Co., the Federal Power Commission said this week.

The commission said in a report prepared from studies by its Bureau of Power such a connection would supplement present transmission links between eastern and western portions of the Northwest Power Pool and would result "in substantial economic savings."

Only "weak circuitous ties" now connect the two systems, the commission said.

The report said a direct tie in

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the Baker-LaGrande area of Oregon would directly affect three private power systems—the Washington Water Power Co., Montana Power Co. and Utah Power & Light Co.—as well as the Bonneville and Idaho Power systems.

The commission said 500 million kilowatt-hours per year of secondary hydro-electric power could be delivered to the Utah-Idaho system, replacing steam-generated power, resulting in an annual savings of \$1,033,000.

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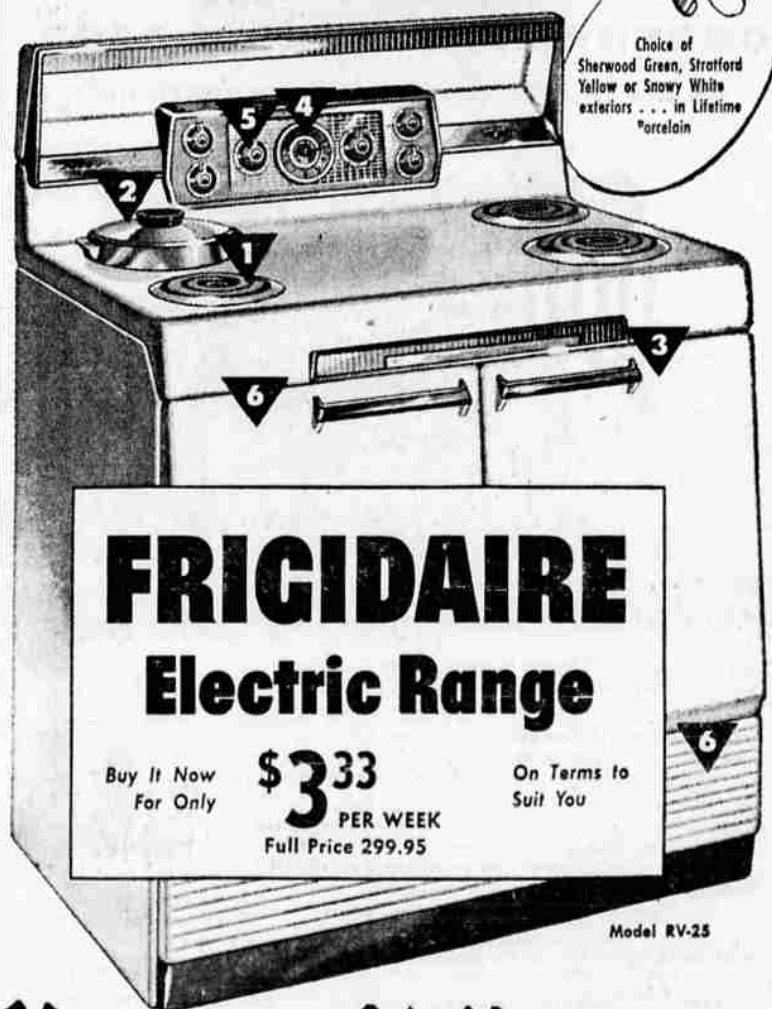
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
