

Former Baby Sitter Denies Killing Child Last Summer

EPHRATA, Wash. (AP)—A former baby sitter, protesting her innocence was jailed here Friday on a first degree murder charge in the death of 21-month-old Deena Starzman at Grand Coulee, Wash., last summer.

Kathleen Carnaghan, 29, was arrested in San Francisco Thursday, flown to Seattle, then brought here by automobile and locked in the county jail at 3 a.m. Friday to await trial.

Meanwhile, Deena's maternal grandmother whose "hunch" reopened the case, described Miss Carnaghan as "100 per cent" and personally.

Mrs. Marie Boines, Grand Coulee cafe owner, said she would not have been kept as a baby sitter "if she wasn't 100 per cent."

Miss Carnaghan was baby sitting with the child the day Deena was found dead face down in a puddle of water in front of the Starzman home. It was reported as a case of accidental drowning.

Prosecutor Paul Klusen had the baby's body exhumed on Mrs. Baines' request and a pathologist gave the cause of death as a heavy blow on the head.

Asked Friday what caused her to doubt the drowning, Mrs. Baines said:

"How could a child drown in two inches of water? I couldn't believe she had drowned because of the way the ground lay. There was just lawn under the water."

Mrs. Baines said "I'm not going to say any more."

Rut Deena's parents, who now live on a farm near Newport, Wash., said they couldn't believe Miss Carnaghan could be guilty.

"She worshipped Deena and was wonderful with the children. It was none of her doing," Mrs. Starzman said.

Miss Carnaghan declined to talk with reporters in Seattle. In San Francisco Thursday, however, she stoutly protested her innocence through her counsel, Deputy Public Defender Mully Minduri.

Payments To Employes For Ideas Gets Approval

SALEM (AP)—The Legislature's Joint Ways and Means Committee thinks it would be OK to spend a little money for some good ideas.

It approved a bill Friday to let the state pay its employes for suggestions that could save it money.

C. W. Terry, state civil service director, said this suggestion box plan is similar to that used in private industries.

The bill envisions merit awards totaling not more than \$20,000 in the next two years. Cost of the program would be divided among state agencies.

It would create a board of department chiefs to review all suggestions for trimming state expenses, and send acceptable ideas to the governor. Cash awards would be based on their money-saving value.
