Mrs. Nichols got top payoff with her 1687 all-events figure and then teamed with Dell Mix, with whom

she has three times won the state doubles crown, to nab top doubles score of 1100.

Mrs. Slack rolled 79 for the best singles effort of the day and totaled 1,640 pins for high handicap all-events.

In all, there were payoffs to six doubles teams, 10 singles entries, one scratch all-events winner and nine places in all-events handicap. About 80 women took part.

**AS USUAL,** Class "C" came through with some of the very highest handicap scores. Of five all events totals above 1900, three were by Class C men, including Brusseau's 1889, Irvin Gledit's 1986, second high for the tournament, and Eldon (Red) Lee's 1982.

Tournament oddities showed up in all events totals for the first time. Eldon Lee had 686-658-658, Stan Cornutt 577-573-573, Willard Thompson 657-570, and Don Weinberg 612-579-579. Chuck Hop-

kings had an up-and-down ladder, by tens 134-144-154, and a ditto by Fred Aamot, 168-176-188. Vinnie Nordling had a pair of 178s, Leo Justen 172s, Lloyd Bailey 146s, Curly Siekman 147s, while Dilly Dilworth and Jim Pope had sand-dance totals, respectively 146-183-146 and 149-140-149.

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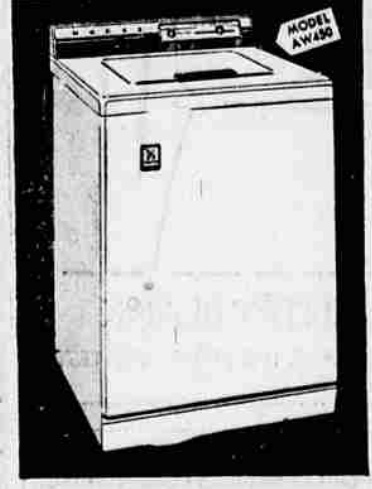
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
