

Idaho Man New Head Of Wool Growers Assn.

SALT LAKE CITY (AP) — An Idaho man, John H. Breckenridge of Twin Falls, has been moved up to the presidency of the National Wool Growers Assn., it was announced Monday.

J. M. Jones, executive secretary, said the organization's executive committee chose Breckenridge to fill the vacancy caused by the death March 31 of Wallace Ulmer of Miles City, Mont.

Ulmer was elected at the association's convention last December.

Breckenridge has been a vice president of the association since 1949, longer than any of the four other vice presidents.
