**Benson Says Farmers In Price-Cost Squeeze**

WASHINGTON (AP) — Secretary of Agriculture Benson told Congress here that farmers are caught in a "price-cost squeeze" that began about four years ago. Benson said "a difficult transition period" will continue for a time but added that the long-time outlook for the U.S. farmer is bright. He said the difficulties were caused by shifting from wartime to peacetime economy.

"If our population continues to grow at the current rate, by 1975 we will need about 30 per cent more agricultural products than we are now producing," he said.

Benson was the first witness before a Senate appropriations subcommittee considering the annual farm money bill. It would provide more than a billion dollars in cash and loans to finance agricultural programs in the next fiscal year.
