Walter Alston, the quiet man, watched passively as his Brooklyn Dodgers set a modern major league record by winning their 10th straight since the start of the season. Then he stroled back to the clubhouse, where he fouled off two questions and smirked a third.

The first was a knuckler, hard to handle. "How long can you keep going?"

Alston puffed his cigarette. "That's anybody's guess."

The second was a curve that hung up high. "Is it the spirit? Is it better than last year?"

Alston unbuttoned his uniform shirt. "The spirit's always good when a team is winning."

The third was a fat one. "What's kept you winning?"

Alston loosened his trousers. "A combination. Hitting. Pitching. Fielding."

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For a guy on the spot after the Brooks' loss in '54, Alston wasn't much like a manager whose club had just won 10. He was more like Edie Stanky after losing four.

The matter - of - factness was evident among all the Dodgers. "I was on a club (Chicago Cubs) that won 21 straight once," said Coach Billy Herman. "We ain't even half way there yet."

"Hell," said Duke Snider. "We still got 144 to play."

That's the way it was yesterday after the Brooklyn had become the first team since 1900 to win its first 10 games. To do it, they put the slug on Bob Roberts' unbeaten record, pasting the best right-hander in baseball and the Philadelphia Phils 14-4.

It was the only National League game played, New York at Pittsburgh was rained out. In the American, Washington knocked off the first place Boston 1-0, Chicago

Minors' TV, Radio Ban Try Snagged

NEW YORK (AP) — Minor league baseball's latest bid to ban major league broadcasts and telecasts in its territory has hit a snag with the big leagues' filing dismissal motions against a \$250,000 damage suit brought by the owner of the Portsmouth, Va., club.

Commissioner Ford Frick, both major leagues and their clubs filed the motions Thursday in Federal Court. They contended there was an error in venue, since neither of the leagues is in residence in New York. National League headquarters are in Cincinnati and the American League's in Chicago.

The suit against the majors was brought by Frank D. Lawrence, Portsmouth banker and owner of the Class B Piedmont League's Portsmouth franchise. He charges that repeated beaming of major league broadcasts into Piedmont territory "has substantially reduced attendance" at games played by his club and "threatens to make impossible the profitable continuation of minor league competition."

Arguments in the case were scheduled for May 3, but counsel indicated the dismissal motions would postpone the opening.

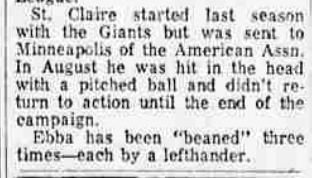
Mrs. Ethel Quimby, who has been tying flies for 25 years, says that fish are color blind. It is the motion of the fly that attracts the fish, she says.
