She was married at Traverse City, Mich., on May 18, 1903, to John Lindstrom who preceded her in death on Feb. 1, 1941. She was married at Rockwell City, Iowa, on April 2, 1942 to Francis Hutton, who preceded her in death on Jan. 19, 1951. Later in 1951 she came to Roseburg to make her home near Melrose.

Surviving are a son, Ivar Lindstrom, Melrose; a sister, Mrs. Hilmar Oleson, Sweden, four grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

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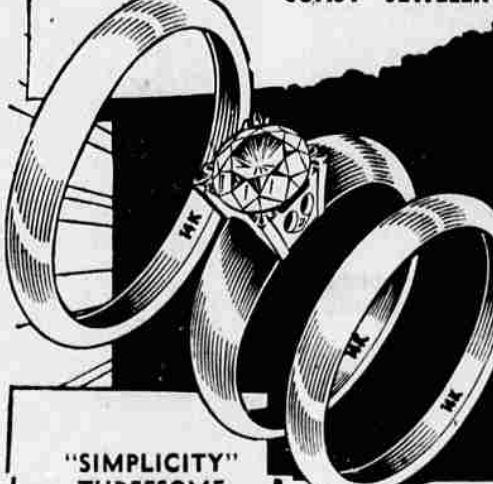
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
