

Coon Puzzled Only One Dam Is Recommended

SALEM (AP) — Rep. Sam Coon said here Monday that he can't fully understand the Federal Power Commission examiner's recommendation that Idaho Power Co. be allowed to construct only one dam in Hell's Canyon.

Coon, who met here with Gov. Paul Patterson before flying back

to Washington, said: "It appears to me that construction should be expedited on all three of the proposed units of the Idaho Power Co. development. I will urge that the known need for more power in Oregon and the rest of the Pacific Northwest be given primary consideration by the Federal Power Commission when it renders its decision on the matter."

Coon, who comes from Baker near the canyon, said it is possible that the commission would approve the other two units.

Coon said people are supporting his bill for construction of John Day Dam through partnership between the government and private or public local interests.

"I came out here," he said, "to find out what the people are thinking, and I have found surprisingly large support for my bill."

He denied rumors that he would resign to accept a federal job. He added he hasn't been approached for one.

He asserted that he is "confident that there is a good chance" to get Williamette Iron and Steel Co., Portland, a contract for converting two tankers into passenger ships for the Matson Navigation Co.

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Walter Pigeon Shows No Signs Of Slowing Down

HOLLYWOOD (AP) — After 30 years in the movies, Walter Pigeon shows no signs of slowing down. To demonstrate his durability, MGM is pitting him against a robot in a space epic, "Forbidden Planet." Now he has done everything.

Pigeon has come a long way from the Canadian boy who broke into the movies in 1925 with Dolores Costello in "The Mannequin." It took Hollywood 15 years to cash in on his suave talents.

Born in St. John, N. B., he won his first notice as the singing partner of Elsie Janis. He never made too great a dent on the public consciousness until 1937, when he first signed with MGM. He became—and remains—the most serviceable actor on the lot.

Perhaps his greatest fame came as costar with Greer Garson. They starred together in "Blossoms in the Dust" and carried on through "Mrs. Miniver," "Madame Curie," "Mrs. Parkington," "Julia Misbehaves," "That Forsythe Woman,"

"The Miniver Story" and "Scandal at Scourie."

Last year Miss Garson left MGM to become a free lance, so a future costarring does not appear likely. Walter retains a lively interest in her career and raved about her TV debut in "Reunion in Vienna."

When Greer decided to leave the old home lot, Walter made the decision to stay on.

"This studio takes good care of its people," he explained. "I'd be lost anywhere else. So last August signed on for another three years. It's the same kind of deal I had before—exclusive services for five pictures every two years."

"When the contract's over, I'll probably never quit entirely. But it will be nice to slow down a bit."
