Neurotics Most Likely To Appear On Surgical Table

ATLANTIC CITY, N. J. (AP)—Emotionally disturbed people may be the most likely candidates to wind up on a surgical operating table, a team of psychiatrists said Thursday.
 Describing studies of 200 randomly chosen surgical patients at a hospital, Dr. Israel Zwerling of New York State College of Medicine, said the group contained "a very high proportion of individuals presenting neurotic symptoms, disturbed behavior or psychotic signs."
 He and three psychiatrists of the University of Cincinnati declared in a joint report to the 111th annual meeting of the American Psychiatric Assn.:
 "This finding of high incidence of emotional disorder can not be explained within the scope of this study. However, it may very possibly be that surgical illness is more likely to befall the emotionally disturbed person."
 They noted four categories among the cases in point:
 1. A group presenting symptoms which were similar to common surgical complaints "but were actually physiologic concomitants (accompaniments) of neurotic illness."
 2. A "large" group in which behavior arising out of "neurotic conflict" produced surgical illness—for example, an accident case resulting from "impulsive, aggressive action."
 3. A group in which psychological factors "operate in complicated ways to produce actual tissue damage and thus surgical illness—for example, peptic ulcer."
 4. A group in which the physical ailment had been aggravated by psychological factors—"such as ailments made worse by psychologically induced delay in seeking surgical care."
