SHOWS IMPROVEMENT

Fred A. Hetzel, director of the U. S. Employment Service for the District of Columbia, was testifying on possible closer cooperation between his organization and district school job counselors, Langer was presiding as temporary subcommittee chairman.

"In Arizona," Langer suddenly roared, "8,000 Indian children have

never gone to school. Who's to blame for this?"

Hetzel, who's probably more familiar with Arizona as a pretty avenue in the northwest section of this city, looked at his boss, Charles E. Odell, chief of counseling for USES.

Odell replied USES, an employment agency, wasn't responsible

for Indian education. Hetzel proceeded with his testimony, turning to a youth council set up by the commissioners who govern Washington.

"What does the council have to say about Indians?" Langer boomed, stalking around the hearing room and chewing on his always-present unwrapped, unlighted cigar.

Subcommittee counsel James H. Bobo explained the council was a strictly local organization.

Mrs. Mildred Perry, a district school official, was the next witness. She complained about budget cuts.

"I guess it's your own fault," Langer said. "You never come to see us about it."

Mrs. Perry said that would be improper, that law forbids individual appropriation requests.

"You mean to say you can't come up here and see your sen-

Bidding Is Light On Auction Sale

NEW YORK (AP) — Bidding was light Wednesday as the auction sale of the 114-year-old Brooklyn Eagle got under way.

Some 200 persons sat in on the initial bidding, with portions of the paper's mechanical equipment being sold for slightly more than \$90,000—about one-tenth of its estimated value.

The three-day sale continued Thursday.

Most of the purchases of 450 items were made by second-hand machinery dealers. Many bids were rejected as too low.

The Eagle ceased publication last Jan. 29 following a strike over wages by the CIO American Newspaper Guild. Members of mechanical craft unions refused to cross picket lines of the editorial and business department workers.

During Wednesday's sale \$8,000 was the highest bid for the name, goodwill, circulation lists and clippings of the Eagle. The auctioneer had asked \$100,000. The bid was rejected.

The Eagle had a daily circulation of 130,000 and 165,000 on Sunday.

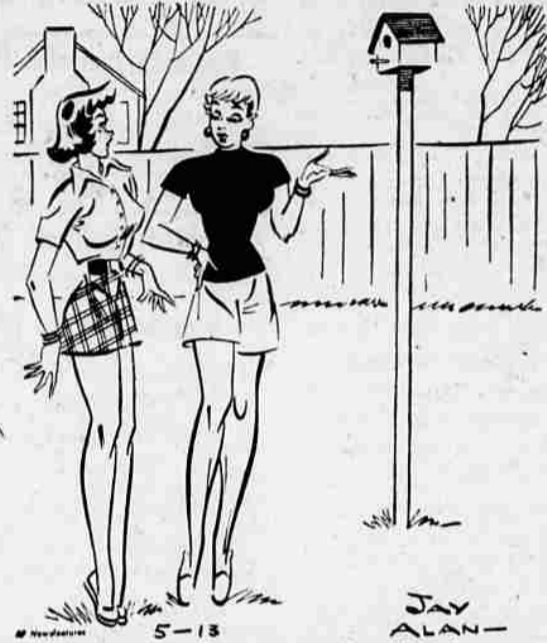

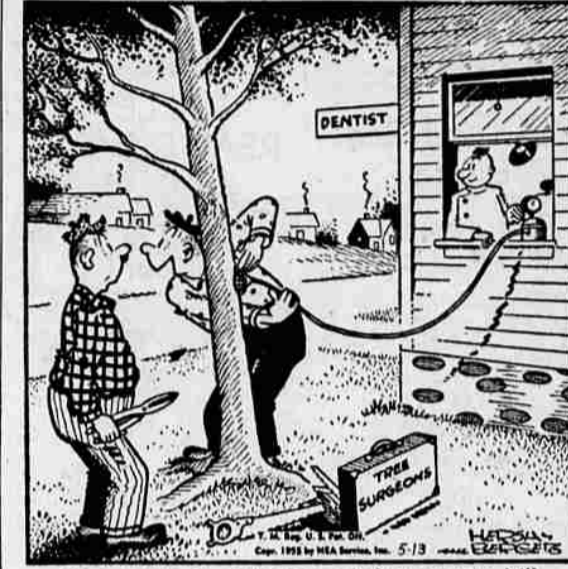
