No Additional Hearings Slated On Hells Canyon

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Senate reclamation subcommittee has no plans for additional hearings on a bill to authorize a federal Hells Canyon Dam and may vote on the measure "in about 10 days or two weeks," Chairman Anderson (D-NM) said Tuesday.
 Anderson said the subcommittee will consider the legislation after members have studied testimony taken by a Federal Power Commission examiner during lengthy hearings on Idaho Power Co.'s application to build three dams in or near the Hells Canyon area of the Snake River.

 TAIPEI, Formosa (AP) — An official Chinese Nationalist news agency said Wednesday a detachment of Communist militiamen revolted in Southern Hunan early in April and joined Nationalist guerrillas after battling a company of public security guards who tried to overpower them.

 MANILA (AP) — About 2100 children of military personnel at the big U.S. Clark Air Force Base north of Manila received a second injection of the new Salk polio vaccine Tuesday. A spokesman said no difficulties with the vaccine have been reported at Clark.

Man Thrown From Horse Said Slightly Improved

PORTLAND (AP) — Allen Owen, 18, injured April 27 when thrown by a horse while working on a ranch near Hermiston, is slowly improving in a hospital, his physician said here Thursday.
 The doctor reported his level of consciousness is gradually becoming higher and he "definitely is on the upgrade." The physician estimated his recovery at "35 to 40 per cent," which he called encouraging in view of the youth's poor condition when he was brought here.
 Young Owen occasionally opens his eyes and has regained some use of an arm and leg, the doctor said, but any recognition could be described as "fleeting" and an "unconscious reaction."
