PHOTO TIPS

In the interest of better snapshots of people, the "police lineup" pose, where the subject squarely faces the camera, should be avoided. Pictures of this type no doubt serve their purpose as records of people; however, it is a simple matter to make them attractive, as well. Just turning the body to a position that does not directly face the camera is improvement in itself. The pose will be even more pleasing if the foot nearest the camera is then advanced slightly, and the knee flexed.

This stance can also be used with groups. If a formal effect is wanted, such as required for wedding parties, the subjects can be placed in a line with each one turned toward the center. For informal shots, more liberty can be taken in arranging the figures, and some people can even be sitting or kneeling; but straight-in angles should still be avoided.

With seated people, the straight-in view is especially bad, as distortion will usually make the legs look unduly large. The seated figure, therefore, should be taken at an angle, or else the subject should be seated on the edge of the chair with knees turned to the side.

A pleasing pose can also be attained by taking advantage of surroundings. For example, the subject can be posed leaning against a fence, or with a foot raised on a stairway.

Rayonier Corp. Announces Plans For Huge Plant

PARIS (AP) — Rayonier, Inc., the world's largest producer of chemical cellulose, Tuesday disclosed plans for a new 30-million dollar plant expected to increase the American corporation's annual output to 880,000 tons.

Rayonier directors, ending their first board meeting overseas, said construction will begin as soon as plans can be drawn and production will start within two years. Clyde B. Morgan, Rayonier president, said corporation engineers will choose the site for the plant, but indicated it probably will be located in Southeastern United States. He said the plant eventually will have an annual 5-million-dollar payroll.

Two Men Survive Plunge 200 Feet Over Bank

NEHALEM, Ore. (AP) — Two men survived a 200-foot plunge over an embankment in a truck cab late Tuesday. One remained hospitalized Wednesday.

The men, Willard Lindman of Seaside and Henry Grasseth of Nehalem, were hauling a Jonkey engine up Lost Creek Road. Suddenly the trailer hitch broke and the truck cab plunged over the bank. Brought out by the Nehalem Logging Co. ambulance, Grasseth was treated for bruises and released but Lindman was hospitalized at Seaside with more serious hurts.

WANT PINBALL HEARING

PORTLAND (AP) — Portland's ordinance making pinball machines illegal should get a public hearing before it becomes effective, the AFL Teamsters Union told the City Council in a letter here. Many small shopkeepers depend on the revenue from pinball machines, the letter said. The ordinance will become effective as soon as the state Supreme Court sends a copy of its recent ruling upholding it.

Rayonier now has plants at Shelton, Hoquiam, and Port Angeles, Wash., Fernandina, Fla., Jesup, Ga., and Vancouver, B.C., and is expanding in Canada. Morgan said the board meeting was held here to acquaint members with the European market and to "impress our customers in Europe that we take their affairs seriously." It was one of the few board meetings ever held by a United States corporation abroad.

U. S. Agrees To Permit Soviet Farmers' Visit

WASHINGTON (AP) — The United States has agreed to permit an official delegation of Soviet farmers to visit American farm areas. The State Department, in announcing this, said an unofficial group of American farmers also will visit the Soviet Union under the exchange plan. The visits will take place "some time during the coming summer." By accepting Russia's proposal that the Soviet farmers come "as an official delegation" it will not be necessary to fingerprint the visitors before they enter the United States. Russia cancelled a visit of 11 student editors, who were scheduled to arrive April 19, when it objected to requirements that they be fingerprinted in applying for American visas.

IKE PETITIONS SCANNED—Mrs. Paul Geddes, wife of Roseburg's state senator, accepts Eisenhower nominating petitions from Henry Buehner, Portland attorney, at Oregon's statehouse. Buehner has been active in nation's first formal effort to place President Eisenhower's name on next year's ballot. Signatures of 1,000 Oregon Republicans are required to put Ike in Oregon's 1956 GOP primary, but Buehner predicted that "many, many times that number" will be obtained.

News Briefs

COMMUNIST CLAIMS
HONG KONG (AP) — The Communist New China News Agency reported Wednesday that the Chinese Nationalists flew 11,028 sorties over the Red China coastal area in April. Total casualties on the mainland were two dead and seven wounded, the agency said.

TO SALVAGE GOLD
MANILA (AP) — The Philippine government decided Wednesday to invite bids for the salvaging of gold bullion and other treasure believed dumped by Japanese military forces in Northern Philippine waters in World War 88.

PUBLISHERS GATHER
COPENHAGEN (AP) — Some 160 editors and publishers from all continents gathered here Wednesday to discuss aspects of the free press during the fourth general assembly of the International Press Institute.

PANMUNJOM (AP) — The Neutral Nations Supervisory Commission, which polices the armistice in Korea, says Red charges that the United Nations brought combat material into Korea were "not proved." The decision of the four-nation NNSC was unanimous, the commission said.

Portlander Is Candidate For GOP Treasurer's Job

PORTLAND (AP) — Henry Buehner, a Portland attorney, has announced his candidacy for treasurer of the Republican State Central Committee.

The post will be vacant because of the recently announced resignation of Lawrence Neault, Baker. Buehner is the only announced candidate.

Also to be elected at the committee's meeting here May 21 is a new chairman to succeed Ed G. Boehnke, Eugene, who also is resigning.

Wendell Wyatt, Astoria, is the only announced candidate for that position.

ANOTHER BOMB THREAT

PORTLAND (AP) — The bomb threats which a week ago were occurring with some regularity here, persist. One turned up Tuesday at Sitton school but as usual there was no explosion.

A man was reported to have phoned at 8:15 a. m. to report a bomb "in one of the basements." The school has only one basement. Police made a check but found nothing.

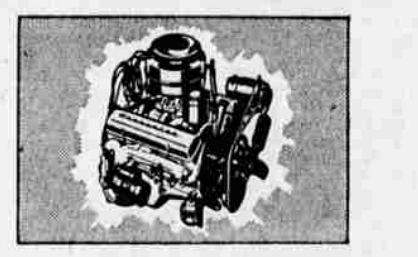
