Peiping Charges U.S. Seized 500 Residents

TOKYO (AP) — Peiping Radio charged this week that "500 residents of the Haiphong area were seized by the U.S. Navy and shipped to South Viet Nam Sunday" aboard the transport General A. W. Brewster.
The broadcast quoted "American press reports."
It said half a dozen Navy Transports and other American ships were standing by close to the Haiphong area "to join in the abduction of civilians. Every three out of eight people forced to go South were transported by American ships," the broadcast said.

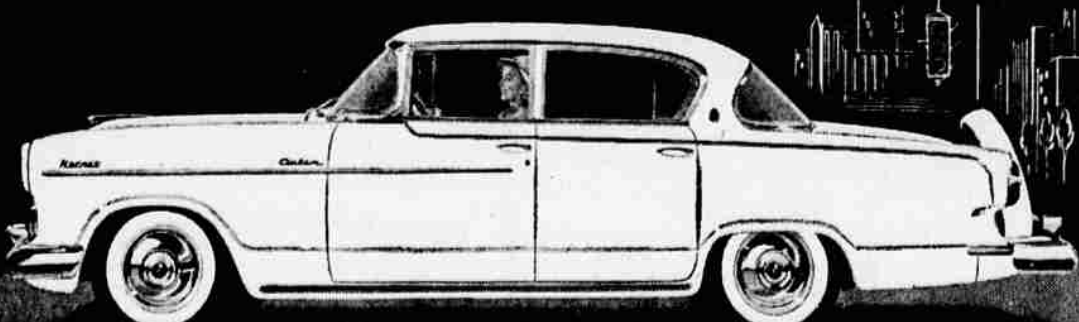
