PARKING LOT PROPOSED

PORTLAND — An underground parking lot in downtown Portland, big enough to handle 300 cars, was proposed here by Francis E. Young, president of a San Diego construction firm.

He proposed to Mayor Fred L. Peterson that one of the south Park Blocks be leased to him for 40 or 50 years at a rental of \$1 a year. He would build the lot and return the property to the city at the end of the lease period.

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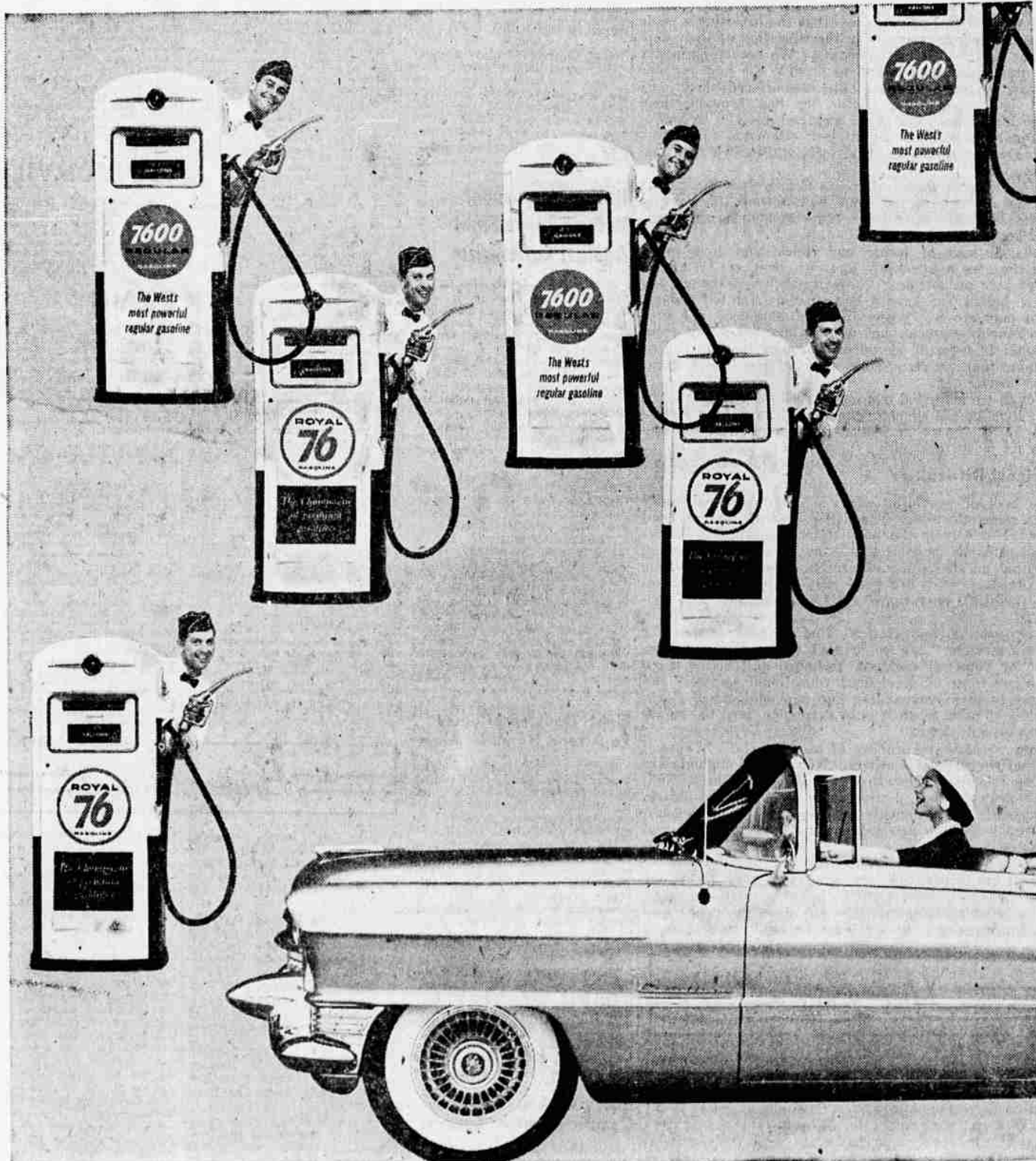
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
